Day 1: Amsterdam (Netherlands)

Every turn of the river reveals a new vista, offering quiet reflection or a moment to capture the perfect memory.</p>

Day 6: Würzburg (Germany)

<p>WÜRZBURG. Würzburg's Baroque architecture and elegant streets reflect a rich cultural heritage. Explore the grand façades, intricate gardens, and riverbanks that have inspired travelers for generations. Whether wandering the streets or hiking to vantage points, the city's beauty and charm provide a serene backdrop for leisurely exploration.</p>

Day 7: Eltmann (Germany)

<p>ELTMANN – BAMBERG. Today, you will explore the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Bamberg. Take a guided tour of this medieval gem to see its diverse architecture, from the cathedral to its elegant mansions. Or taste your way through town, sampling smoked beer, pralines, and hörnla pastries. As a Smithsonian Journeys Exclusive, walk along the historic Ludwig Canal to Lock 100, still in use today.</p>

Day 8: Nuremberg (Germany)

<p>NUREMBERG. Nuremberg's streets rise beneath its castle, blending centuries of architecture, art, and history. Wander the Old Town, discover local traditions, and feel the energy of a city that has shaped Europe's past. Every turn offers a glimpse into the city's stories, from grand squares to quiet courtyards.</p>

Day 9: Nuremberg (Germany)

<p>NUREMBERG. Nuremberg's cobblestone streets wind past medieval towers, ancient fountains, and colorful façades that whisper centuries of stories. The city's rhythm blends history, artistry, and everyday life, inviting quiet strolls and moments of reflection. From the Old Town's charming squares to the riverbanks that frame its skyline, Nuremberg reveals a city shaped by time, culture, and enduring spirit.</p>

Day 10: Regensburg (Germany)

<p>REGENSBURG. Explore Regensburg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that was once the seat of the Holy Roman Empire. Discover the Roman-era Porta Praetoria and the Old Town Hall. As a Smithsonian Journeys Exclusive, visit the House of Bavarian History Museum, acclaimed for its architecture as well as its exhibitions, and see the impressive monument of Walhalla, built in the style of a Greek temple honouring cultural, scientific and artistic contributions of German speaking celebrities.</p>

Day 11: Passau (Germany)

<p>PASSAU. Arrive in Passau, situated where the Danube meets the Inn and Ilz rivers. As a Smithsonian Journeys Exclusive, spend the day in Salzburg where on your walking tour you will see sights from The Sound of Music. Tour Salzburg's UNESCO-designated Old Town, from Mozart's

home to the gardens of Mirabell Palace. Or stay in Passau and enjoy a walking tour with hand-made pretzels and chocolates, a guided bike ride, or a hike to the Veste Oberhaus Fortress.

Day 12: Melk (Austria)

MELK, AUSTRIA. Enter the breathtaking Wachau Valley, a UNESCO-listed stretch of the Danube River. As a Smithsonian Journeys Exclusive, tour the Benedictine Melk Abbey, a marvel of Baroque architecture perched above the river, and meet a librarian to learn how medieval books are meticulously restored. Alternatively, hike up to the abbey or embark on a guided bike tour along the Danube River.
