Day 1: Budapest (Hungary)

ARRIVE IN BUDAPEST, HUNGARY – EMBARKATION. Board the ship in Budapest for your Magnificent Europe cruise. (D)

Day 3: Vienna (Austria)

<p>VIENNA, AUSTRIA. Vienna's grand avenues and Baroque architecture convey the legacy of the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Stroll the streets, admire palaces, or take in the rhythm of life in this elegant city. Every corner of Vienna offers history, artistry, and a welcoming sense of refinement.</p>

Day 4: Dürnstein (Austria)

<p>DÜRNSTEIN – MELK, AUSTRIA. The heart of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, Vienna, remains as renowned today as it has throughout history. The entire city center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site awash with Baroque treasures. Your city tour showcases its regal splendors, including the majestic Opera House and the former Imperial Palace of the Habsburgs. Conclude in Vienna's historic city center and then visit the majestic St. Stephen's Cathedral, which has stood watch over Vienna for 700 years and is one of the most important and beloved landmarks in Austria. Alternatively, enjoy a guided bike tour through Vienna. (B,L,D)</p>

<p>ENGELHARTSZELL, GERMANY – PASSAU, GERMANY. Enjoy a morning of scenic cruising on your way to Engelhartzell, your jumping off point for excursions in Passau. Discover Passau in one of three ways. Enjoy a walking tour and marvel at Gothic and Italian Baroque architecture and St. Stephen's Cathedral. Guests looking for a more active excursion can choose between a guided bike tour along the Danube, or a guided hike up to the Veste Oberhaus Fortress. For those who love <i>The Sound of Music</i>, you can also choose to enjoy a full-day excursion to Salzburg and tour the historic center, Mirabell Gardens, Residenz Square and the Old Market. Day 6: Regensburg (Germany)

<p>REGENSBURG, GERMANY. Explore one of Germany's best preserved medieval cities, Regensburg, on a guided walking tour showcasing the city's architectural highlights, including the Old Town Hall and the Porta Praetoria. As an alternate option, sample some of Bavaria's

specialties—beer, sausage and pretzels. And for a more active adventure, bike to Walhalla where you will see the neoclassical white marble temple. (B,L,D)</p>

Day 7: Nuremberg (Germany)

<p>NUREMBERG, GERMANY. Nuremberg's streets rise beneath its castle, blending centuries of architecture, art, and history. Wander the Old Town, discover local traditions, and feel the energy of a city that has shaped Europe's past. Every turn offers a glimpse into the city's stories, from grand squares to quiet courtyards.</p>

Day 8: Nuremberg (Germany)

<p>NUREMBERG, GERMANY. You have two choices of excursions while in Nuremberg. Turn back the pages of a darker history with a guided tour of the city's most important WWII sites, including the coliseum. You'll also visit the Nuremberg Trials Memoriam and Courtroom 600, if the courtroom is not in session. Alternatively, partake in a traditional Franconian specialties tasting of famous Nuremburger bratwurst, rotbier (red beer) and lebkuchen (gingerbread). (B,L,D)</p>

Day 9: Bamberg (Germany)

<p>BAMBERG, GERMANY. Explore enchanting Bamberg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, in one of three ways. Join a guided walking tour of this medieval gem to see its cathedral, Old Town Hall and elegant old mansions. Or taste your way through the city sampling smoked beer, pralines, and Hornla, a pastry. And for a more active adventure, join a guided bike tour. (B,L,D)</p>

Day 10: Würzburg (Germany)

<p>WÜRZBURG, GERMANY. You have several choices of excursions. Join a walking tour of Würzburg nestled along the "Romantic Road," or visit its crown jewel, the Baroque Residenz, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. If you prefer to get more active, hike up to the Marienberg Fortress, the most prominent landmark on the left bank of the Main River in Würzburg. Alternatively, go to Rothenburg, the best-preserved medieval town in Germany. The town is so pretty that the imagery of Walt Disney's Pinocchio was very much influenced by sketches of Rothenburg.

<p>WERTHEIM – MILTENBERG. Wertheim's picturesque streets and gentle riverbanks reveal a town shaped by centuries of history. Stroll through quiet squares, wander along the water, or cycle through the surrounding valleys, savoring the calm rhythm of this charming region.</p>
