Day 1: Amsterdam (Netherlands)

<p>AMSTERDAM – EMBARKATION. Arrive in Amsterdam and settle into your cabin, docked where the city’s charm and riverside nightlife will welcome you.</p>

<p>AMSTERDAM – KAMPEN, NETHERLANDS. Later in the day, step into a fairytale at De Haar Castle or enjoy a guided bike ride through the city.</p>

Day 3: Utrecht (Netherlands)

UTRECHT, NETHERLANDS. Enjoy a scenic morning cruise through the delta before arriving in Hellevoetsluis, a charming island town in South Holland. Stroll through its cobblestone streets to admire the working De Hoop windmill and quaint wharf houses. Later, uncover the fascinating story of the Delta Works and visit the Flood Museum, or hop aboard a traditional Dutch flat-bottom boat to learn about this unique vessel. Adventure seekers can join a guided bike ride from Hellevoetsluis across the Haringvlietdam and back.

Day 4: Gent (Ghent) (Belgium)

GHENT, BELGIUM. Spend the day in Ghent with options to suit every interest. Take a walking tour through the historic streets or explore the town on a guided bike ride. Or, embark on a full-day excursion to Bruges to see the Church of Our Lady with Michelangelo's Madonna and Child and enjoy a beer tasting, or opt for a shorter Bruges visit later in the day. Back in Ghent, explore the moated Castle of the Counts and conclude with a tasting at a local brewery.

Day 5: Brussel (Bruxelles) (Belgium)

BRUSSELS, BELGIUM. Uncover Belgium's vibrant capital on a guided walking tour or bike through Laeken Park, admiring the striking Far East Museums and the iconic Atomium sculpture. In the afternoon, tailor your experience with a visit to the medieval Bouchout Castle, a local brewery for a beer tasting, or indulge your sweet side with a decadent Belgian chocolate experience.

Day 6: Antwerp (Belgium)

ANTWERP, BELGIUM. Discover Belgium's dazzling "City of Diamonds" on a guided walking tour showcasing Antwerp's Steen Castle, Grote Market, Brabo Fountain, and the UNESCO-listed Cathedral of Our Lady. For a more active outing, bike through the city's charming streets. Later, savor Belgium's famous flavors on a culinary or beer-tasting excursion, or join an afternoon bike ride that includes a visit to the fascinating Red Star Line Museum.

Day 7: Dordrecht (Netherlands)

<p>DORDRECHT, NETHERLANDS. Explore Dordrecht, Holland’s oldest city, on a guided walking tour uncovering its fascinating past shaped by a 15th-century flood. Alternatively, visit Rotterdam and nearby Delfshaven, where the Pilgrim Fathers began their voyage aboard the Speedwell, or join an architectural bike tour through Rotterdam. In the afternoon, visit the UNESCO-listed Kinderdijk to admire its 18th-century windmills or pedal past these iconic Dutch landmarks.</p>
