Itinerary

Day 1: Arles (France)

<p>ARLES – EMBARKATION. Board your luxurious river ship in the heart of Arles, a city shaped by Roman emperors and immortalized by Van Gogh. As you settle in, the gentle movement of the Rhône and the warm Provençal light signal the start of a meaningful voyage through history, culture, and Black heritage in France.</p>

Day 2: Arles (France)

<p>ARLES. Discover how the Mediterranean has shaped identity, culture, and memory in southern France. Either explore Marseille through its Black heritage and maritime history or wander Arles' ancient streets where Roman ruins, Provençal life, and artistic legacy intersect.</p>

Arrives On: 28 Apr 28

Day 3: Avignon (France)

<p>AVIGNON. Step inside the monumental Papal Palace, a symbol of Europe's religious and political power, and stroll Avignon's fortified streets. In the afternoon, choose between deeper historical exploration or a visit to Fondation Blachère, where modern art meets the dramatic landscapes of the Alpilles.</p>

Arrives On: 29 Apr 28

Day 4: Viviers (France)

<p>VIVIERS. Wander through Viviers' narrow lanes, shaded courtyards, and cathedral views, or venture into the countryside for an immersive truffle hunt with a local farmer and his dog. Whether by foot or bike, the Rhône Valley reveals its timeless charm.</p>

Arrives On: 30 Apr 28

Day 5: Tournon-sur-Rhône (France)

<p>TOURNON. Glide through vineyard-clad hills aboard a historic steam train or hike the famed slopes of Tain-l'Hermitage before tasting some of the Rhône's most celebrated wines. Later, deepen your cultural understanding with a lecture on the global history of jazz.</p>

Arrives On: 01 May 28

Day 6: Vienne (France)

<p>VIENNE. Walk among well-preserved Roman ruins that still define Vienne's landscape, or explore its surrounding heights by hike or bike. The day also includes a thought-provoking lecture on the history of French colonialism and its lasting impact.</p>

Arrives On: 02 May 28

Day 7: Lyon (France)

<p>LYON. Savor Lyon's renowned gastronomy on a tasting tour through local markets and traditional eateries. Later, visit the Tata of Chasselay memorial honoring Senegalese soldiers of World War II, followed by a Beaujolais wine tasting. The day culminates in a Juneteenth celebration recognizing Black history, resilience, and community.</p>

Arrives On: 03 May 28

Day 8: Lyon (France)

<p>LYON – DISEMBARKATION. Disembark your river ship in Lyon and board the sleek TGV high-speed train to Paris. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and settle into the elegant rhythm of

France's capital, where art, history, and culture await.</p>
