Day 1: Lyon (France)

<p>LYON – EMBARKATION. Step aboard your luxurious vessel and set sail from Lyon, a city alive with culinary delight and rich heritage. Allow the gentle rhythm of the Rhône to set the tone for the intimate and indulgent days ahead.</p>

Day 2: Lyon (France)

Day 3: Lyon (France)

<p>LYON – VIENNE. Journey into the golden-hued landscapes of the Beaujolais wine region. Indulge in a private tasting at a traditional winery and experience the romance of sun-dappled vineyards that have enchanted travelers for centuries.</p>

Day 4: Vienne (France)

<p>VIENNE – TOURNON. Explore Vienne’s Roman past along streets lined with ruins, Gothic cathedrals, and medieval abbeys. For the active traveler, follow scenic trails or cycle along the ViaRhôna, taking in the serene landscapes that have inspired generations.</p>

Day 5: Tournon-sur-Rhône (France)

<p>TOURNON - VIVIERS. Take a steam train ride past magnificent landscape carved along the Gorge du Doux, stopping at the charming little station of Colombier le Vieux-Saint Barthélemy le Plain, where the train maneuvers in preparation for its return journey. Alternatively, lovers of wine and chocolate will want to visit Le Château de Tournon for a presentation and tasting on the pairing of red wine and chocolate. For a more active adventure, take a hike through the vineyards of Tain l’Hermitage, followed by a visit to a local winery where you’ll sample some of the wines. Later, stroll through the city accompanied by a guide in Renaissance attire as former “residents” in period costumes reenact events and legends of centuries gone by. This special historical tour is sure to bring a smile to your lips – or perhaps send shivers down your spine! (B,L,D)</p>
