See John Glenn's space capsule landing site, learn about the island's salt-producing salinas, and keep watch for pink flamingos in their natural habitat. Your stop at the Grand Turk Lighthouse, built in 1852, offers sweeping views over the turquoise waters and dramatic cliffs. From January to March, you may even spot humpback whales offshore. Expect a fun, dusty adventure that shows a wilder side of Grand Turk. Drivers must be at least 18 years old and present a valid driving licence.

relaxation and gentle adventure. After a short introduction, mount your well-trained horse and set off along quiet tracks leading to the beach. Enjoy a scenic coastal ride with sweeping ocean views before entering the water for the highlight of the excursion – a unique horseback swim in the Caribbean Sea. Guided by experienced handlers, both beginners and confident riders can take part in this tranquil yet exhilarating activity. The combination of land and sea offers a rare perspective of the island, making this excursion particularly special for animal lovers and those seeking something different.
