## Itinerary

### Day 1: Civitavecchia (Italy)

Fly from the UK to Civitavecchia. Your deluxe cruise begins in Civitavecchia, where you'll be transferred to your Emerald Cruises luxury yacht to begin your journey along the Italian coastline.

Located in Southern Italy's Campania region, 20km from Sorrento, it boasts many seaside towns with Italian villas, boutiques and beach clubs hugging the cliffs that rise from the glittering ocean.

Walking tour of Amalfi  
Take a charming walk through the

captivating alleyways of Moorish Amalfi to uncover hidden gems. Start at the stunning Cathedral, exploring the Cloister and Treasures Museum. Learn about ancient papermaking at the Paper Mill Museum. Continue along Via delle Repubbliche Marinare to Piazza Municipio, known as "Campolillo." Wander through the historic district of St. Angelo intra Moenia, discovering sights like the "Alley Trap." End at the Amalfi Paper Museum in a medieval paper mill, where you can witness the traditional papermaking process and admire handmade paper artistry.

The island is renowned for its citrus and olive cultivation. During your cruise, view the Villa of Tiberius and the Blue Grotto, while visiting beaches like "Marina Piccola" and "Bianca Grotto." Afterward, you can explore Capri at your leisure or return to the ship by tender.

Hike in Sorrento  
Embark on a coastal adventure in Sorrento, where history meets natural beauty. Start your journey with a shuttle bus ride to Capo di Sorrento and explore the ancient Roman ruins of Villa Pollio Felix. Discover the remnants of this historic estate before heading to the charming Baths of Queen Giovanna, a serene cove with rocky beaches. Hike back along the scenic coastal trail to Marina Grande, taking in stunning views and local flora. Experience the vibrant heart of Sorrento, rich in history, before concluding your trip at the tranquil Marina Piccola, reflecting on your enchanting journey.

Guided tour of Pompeii (extra expense)  
Step back in time and explore the captivating ruins of Pompeii, frozen in history by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 A.D. This archaeological site showcases the resilience of an ancient Roman town, waiting to be rediscovered. After a scenic 45–60-minute drive, with glimpses of Mount Vesuvius, embark on a guided walking tour through ancient streets, seeing well-preserved mansions, frescoes, and mosaics that reveal the opulence of its 20,000 inhabitants. Enjoy a soft drink and a slice of Neapolitan pizza before returning to Sorrento, with options to explore or head directly to the harbour.

### Day 5: Gaeta (Italy)

Gaeta is a popular holiday destination set on a headland that juts out towards the Gulf of Gaeta, in the Lazio region of Southern Italy. A key attraction in Gaeta is Montagna Spaccata (Split Mountain), a natural sea grotto. According to legend the miraculous split rock was created when God sent a lightning bolt making three giant cracks in the

mountain.

Sperlonga national archaeological museum with Tiberio Villa (extra expense)  
Embark on a half-day adventure in Sperlonga, a stunning town perched on a promontory overlooking the sea. Begin your scenic journey and admire the white houses against the azure backdrop. Visit the National Archaeological

Museum, home to the captivating "Marble Odyssey," featuring ancient sculptures and Emperor Tiberius' residence. Explore a grotto with Roman-age marble works and follow the Flacca Road, a historical trail. Conclude your trip with a leisurely walk through the town center, visiting the Church of St. Mary of Speloncae and the Truglia tower.

### Day 6: Porto Cervo (Italy)

Porto Cervo is a holiday hotspot favoured by discerning travellers drawn to its upscale hotels, luxury boutiques, exceptional restaurants and vibrant nightlife. Porto Cervo's yacht marina is filled with opulent yachts, and the marina hosts prestigious events like the Maxi Yacht Rolex Cup.

Villages of Sardinia and Coddu Vecchiu Giant's Tomb (extra expense)

Drive to San Pantaleo for a brief stop to admire its impressive granite peaks. Continue to the Coddu Vecchiu Archaeological site, home to the Giants' Tomb, a significant example of Nuragic funerary architecture. This well-preserved collective tomb served individuals from the nearby Nuragic Village of La Prisgiona during the Bronze Age. Explore its two-phase construction, featuring a semicircular ceremonial area with a large arched stele. Afterward, visit Baja Sardinia, a charming village with serene views of the Archipelago before returning to Porto Cervo for a leisurely downhill walk back.

Boat tour to La Maddalena (extra expense)

Depart from Porto Cervo to Palau, passing through the charming villages of San Pantaleo and Arzachena. In Palau, board a ferry to La Maddalena Island and enjoy panoramic views of Sardinia's coastline. Stop at Guardia Vecchia for stunning vistas of the Maddalena Archipelago and Corsica. Upon reaching Maddalena, explore the town center, including Garibaldi Square, known as Red Square for its unique red paving. End your day with the return ferry to Palau, then head back to Porto Cervo. Conclude your adventure by returning to the ship or leisurely exploring Porto Cervo.

### Day 7: Bonifacio, Corsica (France)

Perched atop a narrow limestone peninsula, Bonifacio offers breathtaking views of the Mediterranean Sea. Be sure to visit the staircase of the King of Aragon (Escalier du Roi d'Aragon), a steep flight of steps carved into the cliffside, which leads down to the blue-green sea.

Coastal boat trip (extra expense)

Embark on an exclusive coastal exploration from the pier. Board a comfortable boat and sail through the scenic channel between Bonifacio's cliffs, passing the historic "Madonetta"

lighthouse from 1854. Marvel at the "Little Dragon" marine cave and its natural skylight. Glide past "Fazio Creek" and spot landmarks like the "Rudder of Corsica" rock and the legendary King of Aragon's staircase, carved to transport water. The excursion culminates at the "Grain of Sand" rock, a striking 10-meter formation, ideal for memorable photos. Note: This excursion is not recommended for guests suffering from motion sickness, especially in adverse weather conditions.

Highlights of Bonifacio with local tastings (extra expense)

Begin your Bonifacio exploration with a mini train ride through the Bosco quarter, featuring St. Francis convent and a fascinating mariners' cemetery. Enjoy panoramic views of Sardinia and pass the Corsican Gothic St. Dominique church, likely built by the Templars in 1270. Take a walking tour through narrow streets with granite houses, visiting the 14th-century St. Marie Majeure church. Discover Two Emperors Street, Place des Armes, and Jardins des Vestiges.

Your journey continues through the scenic countryside, passing through the historic villages of Corbara and Aregno. Experience the charm of Lucca by e-bike, guided by an expert, for an unforgettable exploration of the town center. Discover notable sites such as the statue of Giacomo Puccini, Piazza San Michele, and San Michele Church, as well as the ancient Roman forum that showcases the blend of the old and the new. The tour then proceeds to Piazza Anfiteatro and Torre Guinigi, iconic landmarks you won't want to overlook. After cycling along the walls, you'll have some leisure time to explore the city.

4x4 Adventure: The famous Carrara Marble Quarries (extra expense)

#### Day 12: Carrara (Italy)

One of Porto Venere's most striking features is the gothic Church of St. Peter, perched atop a rocky headland overlooking the sea.

Walking tour of Porto Venere  
Explore the picturesque medieval village of Portovenere, celebrated by Petrarch as the "panoramic miracle" of the Gulf of La Spezia. Begin your journey at the Roman gateway and stroll along Carugio Capellini, discover Byron's grotto, San Lorenzo Church and admire the artwork inside, including the mysterious Madonna Bianca painting, said to have been discovered washed up from the sea.

Cinque Terre by private boat (extra expense)  
Start your day in Portovenere, a UNESCO-listed town. From there, board your private motorboat and set off to explore the Cinque Terre coast. Next, visit Vernazza, a charming fishing village known for its picturesque port surrounded by soft pastel-coloured buildings. Enjoy some leisure time before returning to Portovenere.
