Day 1: Valletta (Malta)

Your cruise begins in Malta and Valletta, where you'll be transferred to your Emerald Cruises luxury yacht to commence your memorable voyage, sailing through the glorious Mediterranean Sea. Valletta, the tiny capital of Malta and UNESCO World Heritage Centre, is a living testament to the Baroque period, with well-preserved buildings, ornate churches, and magnificent fortifications.

Day 2: Valletta (Malta)

This stunning fortified city is strategically positioned on a hilly peninsula, offering breathtaking views of the Mediterranean Sea. As well as storied history, Valletta is the host of lively markets and festivals.

Begin with a scenic drive to Mdina, Malta's ancient capital, perched on a hilltop with sweeping island views. Often called the "Silent City," Mdina is one of Europe's best-preserved medieval towns. Stroll through its narrow, winding streets as your guide shares over 4,000 years of history. Enjoy free time to visit St. Paul's Cathedral, Palazzo Falson, browse for local crafts, or relax at a charming café.
Continue by coach to Valletta, Malta's bustling present-day capital. Visit the stunning St. John's Co-Cathedral (closed Sundays), then enjoy a guided walking tour passing notable landmarks such as the Grand Master's Palace, Our Lady of Victories Church, and the Renzo Piano-designed Parliament.

Day 4: Lipari (Italy)
