### Day 1: Bridgetown (Barbados)

### Day 2: Soufrière (Saint Lucia)

Here, you can indulge in therapeutic mud baths and sulphur springs, as well as admire the iconic pair of lava domes, Gros Piton and Petit Piton – a World Heritage-listed Site. Be sure to sample the delicious

local cuisine, savouring anything from green figs and salt fish to traditional callaloo soup made with fresh crab or shrimp.

### Day 3: Îles des Saintes (Guadeloupe)

Known as Les Saintes, delightful Îles des Saintes presents a small archipelago of islands and islets with a distinctive fusion of French and Caribbean culture. Discover quaint villages revealing a collection of petite stone buildings and small, white-sand beaches. Don't miss a visit to Fort Napoleon, a significant historical site, which also provides incredible views of one of the islands.

### Day 4: Saint John's (Antigua and Barbuda)

The capital and largest city of Antigua and Barbuda, a twin-island nation located in the Eastern Caribbean, St. John's welcomes with a vibrant and fascinating blend of rich history, beautiful beaches and a lively culture. St John's is also the gateway to other key attractions on the island, such as the historic Nelson's Dockyard and Shirley Heights.
