## Itinerary

### Day 1: Larnaca (Cyprus)

Your memorable journey begins on the southern coast of Cyprus, in the vibrant seaside city, Larnaca, where you will be transferred to your Emerald Cruises luxury yacht. Please book your flight to arrive into Larnaca prior to 04:00 PM.

Arrives On: 02 May 26

### Day 2: Paphos (Cyprus)

The ancient seaport of Paphos is the birthplace of Aphrodite and today, the entire city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. One of this coastal city's iconic landmarks is the Paphos Archaeological Park, home to a remarkable collection of Greco-Roman ruins. Here, you can explore the ancient Odeon amphitheatre and Tombs of the Kings, as well as admire the stunning mosaic floors of four Roman villas.

Arrives On: 03 May 26

### Day 3: Antalya (Turkey)

The stunning view of Antalya is a mesmerising blend of azure skies, dense forests, and the sparkling blue Mediterranean Sea. The rugged Taurus Mountains provide a striking contrast to the city's sun-soaked beaches, making Antalya a paradise for nature lovers. Antalya's rich history unfolds in its well-preserved Old Town, Kaleiçi, where Roman-era harbour walls, Hellenistic gates, and Ottoman-era houses pay homage to the city's storied past.

Arrives On: 04 May 26

### Day 4: Kas (Turkey)

Kas is a small coastal town, renowned for its quaint, whitewashed houses, clear turquoise waters, and ancient ruins. Start your visit by exploring the fascinating ancient ruins scattered across this Turkish town. Be sure to visit the Hellenistic Theatre, built in the 4th century BC, which offers panoramic views across the town and sea.

Arrives On: 05 May 26

### Day 5: Rhodes (Greece)

On the beautiful Greek island of Rhodes, the Medieval City of Rhodes is recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Encircled within four-kilometre length walls, the city's medieval buildings, the Street of the Knights, and the Palace of the Grand Master give you a sense that you are back in the Middle Ages. Known as the 'Island of Knights,' charming Rhodes is also famed for its delicious local dishes – try the melekouni (a traditional sweet) and pitaroudia (chickpea fritters).

Arrives On: 06 May 26

### Day 6: Agios Nikólaos, Kríti (Greece)

A popular coastal town on the Greek island of Crete, Agios Nikolaos rests partially upon the ruins of the ancient city of Lato. This cosmopolitan seaside resort is home to a lake, the town's jewel, known for its many legends – one of which is Athena and Artemis bathing in its waters. The lake becomes one with the sea through a narrow canal and is surrounded by red rock formations and lush vegetation.

Arrives On: 07 May 26

### Day 7: Santorini (Greece)

Known for its spectacular views, gleaming whitewashed architecture and legendary sunsets, Santorini is a hugely popular destination. This gorgeous volcanic island is also famous for its iconic, blue-domed churches and charming villages dramatically perched on cliffs overlooking transparent azure waters. Santorini's picturesque main town, Fira, precariously rests on the edge of a caldera cliff, offering jaw-dropping vistas of the Aegean Sea. Oia, another of Santorini's traditional villages, is particularly renowned for its quaint narrow streets and panoramic views of the caldera.

Arrives On: 08 May 26

#### Day 8: Pátmos (Greece)

A small Greek island in the Aegean Sea, Patmos comes steeped in religious history. The Monastery of Saint John the Theologian, today, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, towers over the island's charming capital, Chora. Nearby, you will find the Cave of the Apocalypse, where, according to local legend, Saint John the Theologian wrote the Book of Revelation.

Arrives On: 09 May 26

#### Day 9: Kusadasi (Turkey)

Along Turkey's western Aegean coast, this beach resort town offers beautiful beaches, a lively atmosphere, and vibrant markets. Kusadasi is also a remarkable destination for history buffs, as it is near several ancient ruins, including the ancient city of Ephesus, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the well-preserved Temple of Artemis. A visit here offers a glimpse into the grandeur and sophistication of one of the ancient world's most important cities.

Arrives On: 10 May 26

#### Day 10: Mykonos (Greece)

Sail to Mykonos, a world-famous Greek island whose allure rests in its blend of traditional Greek culture and cosmopolitan flair. Whitewashed houses with vibrant blue doors edging the winding streets of atmospheric Mykonos Town add to the charm, and so too, the island's historic windmills.

Arrives On: 11 May 26

#### Day 11: Piraeus (Greece)
