Explore the main town, a picturesque labyrinth of quaint narrow

streets lined with shops, cafés and restaurants. The iconic Windmills of Mykonos, situated on a hill overlooking the town, are another must-see attraction.

Explore the island's capital, Chora, an enchanting place revealing whitewashed buildings and narrow cobblestone streets lined with traditional Greek tavernas and shops.

Day 4: Kusadasi (Turkey)
