## Itinerary

### Day 1: Larnaca (Cyprus)

Your journey begins on the southern coast of Cyprus and Larnaca, where you'll be transferred to your Emerald Cruises luxury yacht. A vibrant seaside city, Larnaca is popular for its beautiful beaches, lively waterfront promenade, and rich history. Please book your flight to arrive into Larnaca prior to 04:00 PM.

### Day 2: Paphos (Cyprus)

The ancient seaport of Paphos, mythically celebrated as the birthplace of Aphrodite, is home to one of the island's most important archaeological areas. Much of the city's heritage, including the renowned Paphos Archaeological Park and nearby Tombs of the Kings, is inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore the well-preserved Greco-Roman ruins, from the ancient Odeon amphitheatre to the intricate mosaic floors of four Roman villas depicting scenes from

Greek mythology.

### Day 3: Antalya (Turkey)

Nestled between the Taurus Mountains and turquoise Mediterranean waters, Antalya captivates with its dramatic coastal setting and rich heritage. The UNESCO-listed Kaleiçi Old Town charms visitors with Ottoman-era mansions, Roman harbor gates, and winding cobblestone streets lined with artisanal shops and traditional teahouses. Beyond its historic core, Antalya reveals ancient Hadrian's Gate, Hellenistic towers, and vibrant bazaars that echo the city's layered past from Roman to Seljuk eras.

### Day 4: Rhodes (Greece)

On the lovely Greek island of Rhodes, the Medieval City, or Old Town, is a must-see attraction, recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Encircled within four-kilometre length of walls, the city's medieval buildings, the Street of the Knights, and the Palace of the Grand Master give you a sense that you're back in the Middle Ages. Known as the 'Island of Knights', charming Rhodes is also famed for its delicious local dishes – be sure to try the melekouni (a traditional sweet) and pitaroudia (chickpea fritters).

### Day 5: Agios Nikólaos, Kríti (Greece)

This cosmopolitan coastal town on Crete's scenic northern shore is famed for its relaxed charm and natural beauty. At its centre lies Lake Voulismeni, whose steep cliffs and mythic legends have long fascinated visitors. Spend the day exploring nearby archaeological treasures such as the ancient city of Lato (4th century BC), relaxing on golden-sand beaches, or browsing waterfront boutiques.

### Day 6: Santorini (Greece)

Known for its spectacular views, whitewashed hillside architecture and legendary sunsets, Santorini is a hugely popular destination. This gorgeous Greek Island is also famous for its iconic, blue-domed churches, transparent azure waters, and charming villages dramatically perched on cliffs overlooking the sea. Santorini's picturesque main town, Fira, precariously rests on the edge of a caldera cliff, presenting jaw-dropping vistas of the Aegean Sea. Oia, another of Santorini's traditional villages, is particularly renowned for its quaint narrow streets and panoramic caldera

views. </p></p>

#### Day 7: Mykonos (Greece)

You can also explore the historic Windmills of Mykonos and Little Venice with its stunning seafront homes and from Mykonos itself, visit the sacred island of Delos, a small uninhabited island and UNESCO World Heritage Site, revered as the birthplace of Apollo. </p></p>
