Day 1: Piraeus (Greece)

Day 2: Náfplion (Greece)

Explore the island's capital, Chora, an enchanting place revealing whitewashed buildings and narrow cobblestone streets lined with traditional Greek tavernas and family-run shops.

Day 8: Kusadasi (Turkey)

Set along Turkey's western Aegean coast, Kusadasi blends ancient heritage with lively beach resort charm. This former Ionian Greek port flourished under Byzantine and Ottoman rule, its bazaars still echoing centuries of trade. As gateway to Ephesus—a UNESCO World Heritage Site—Kusadasi offers easy access to one of the antiquity's grandest cities, where the Library of Celsus, Great Theatre, and Temple of Artemis foundations reveal the splendor of Greco-Roman civilization.

Day 9: Chíos (Greece)

The Aegean Island of Chios is famed for its medieval mastic villages, fragrant with the resin that made the island wealthy, and for its well-preserved monasteries. Stroll the narrow alleys of Pyrgi, admire intricate geometric façades, and end the day with fresh seafood at a local taverna.
