Day 1: Piraeus (Greece)

A narrow waterway that connects the Gulf of Corinth with the Saronic Gulf in Greece, the canal was completed in 1893, and it is a feat of engineering. As your luxury yacht navigates through this slender canal, you'll appreciate the stunning views of the soaring, ochre-coloured cliffs. Afterwards, arrive at the picturesque town of Itea, gateway to the

ancient ruins of Delphi, a World Heritage Site and one of the most important archaeological and mythological sites in Greece. The ancient Greeks considered Delphi to be Oracular Sanctuary of Apollo.
