Day 1: Ain Sukhna (Egypt)

Day 3: 'Aqaba (Jordan)

A picturesque coastal city located in the southern tip of Jordan overlooking the Red Sea, Aqaba is a history buffs' delight for its rich history that dates back thousands of years, with archaeological sites such as the Aqaba Fort and the Ayla ruins showcasing its ancient past.
