Day 1: Dubrovnik (Croatia)

Day 2: Dubrovnik (Croatia)

Known as the 'Pearl of the Adriatic,' Dubrovnik presents a compelling city set along Croatia's Dalmatian Coast; its walled Old Town presents one of the finest examples of a medieval citadel in Europe. With its storied history and breathtaking views of iconic terracotta rooftops and the alluring Adriatic Sea, Dubrovnik offers visitors the perfect blend of cultural exploration and a relaxing beach holiday. **Discover MORE** Walking tour of Dubrovnik

(extra expense, must be pre-booked) Embark on a captivating walking tour of Dubrovnik, starting with a scenic coach journey from the pier to Pile Gate. Explore the Franciscan Monastery, where the mesmerizing cloister and Europe's oldest operating pharmacy, dating back to 1317, await you. Discover the Cathedral Treasury, Admire the exterior of other notable sites, soaking in the rich history and architectural beauty of Dubrovnik. Enjoy an authentic taste of Croatian hospitality as you share a traditional cooked meal, prepared just as it would be for the family's own table. This intimate setting offers a genuine glimpse into daily life, local flavours, and time-honoured culinary traditions.

Day 3: Korčula (Croatia)

The sixth-largest island in the Adriatic, Korcula, is among the most beloved in Croatia. Its Old Town, referred to by locals as 'Little Dubrovnik', is a delightful mix of medieval churches, palaces, and photogenic squares, while the villages of Cara and Smokvica are renowned for producing the country's signature dry white wine.

Enjoy a delicious snack and local wine tasting at a charming restaurant before continuing to Lumbarda Beach, where you'll have time to swim in crystal-clear waters and relax in the sun.

Day 4: Kotor (Montenegro)

Nestled between imposing mountains and the Adriatic Sea, this UNESCO World Heritage-listed setting is sure to charm with its elegant Venetian palaces, cobblestone lanes and café-hemmed squares. Guided hike of Kotor's city walls
Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1979, the City Walls of Kotor stretch for almost 5 kilometres, encompassing the city and offering those who embrace the challenge of climbing them, wonderful views of the bay of Kotor and the Old Town. Step back in time as your knowledgeable guide brings to life the history of the fortifications and the important part they played in the protection of the city. Climb to the highest point, where you'll find the well-preserved fortress of St John and be rewarded with a magnificent view of the harbour and the red roofs of the Old Town.

Day 5: Sarandë (Albania)

Wander among Greek, Roman, Byzantine, Venetian, and Ottoman ruins set within lush forests teeming with birdlife and butterflies, while learning the fascinating story of this ancient city. Next, head to Lekursi Castle, a 16th-century Ottoman fortress perched above Saranda. Enjoy panoramic views of the Ionian Sea, the city, and Corfu, especially at sunset, and relax with a refreshing drink at the castle bar before returning to the pier. Day 6: Corfu (Greece)
