Day 1: 'Aqaba (Jordan)

Arrives On: 20 Nov 27

Day 2: 'Aqaba (Jordan)

On the scenic shores of the Red Sea, Aqaba, Jordan's only coastal city is renowned for its stunning coral reefs and sunken vessels. Divers and snorkelling enthusiasts are drawn to the warm, clear waters to explore these underwater ecosystems. Beyond its natural allure, Aqaba holds a significant place in history, inhabited as far back as around 4,000 B.C.

Day 3: Eilat (Israel)

Day 8: Duba (Saudi Arabia)

Welcome to Saudi Arabia and your first stop, Duba, considered the 'Pearl of the Red Sea. Nestled along the Red Sea's stunning northern coast, this historic city attracts visitors for its pleasantly mild climate and excellent beaches, perfect for swimming and sunbathing. Arrives On: 27 Nov 27

Day 10: Yanbu al-Bahr (Saudi Arabia)

Yanbu is renowned as Saudi Arabia's diving capital, due to its clear, warm waters teeming with diverse marine species and some of the most pristine coral reefs on the planet. Back on land, step back in time and discover the traditional buildings of Yanbu. Some are constructed from mud and stone, but in the Old Town of Yanbu, Yanbu Al-Balad, the historic buildings are made from coral stone, a nod to the city's past as an ancient seaport.

Arrives On: 29 Nov 27

Day 11: Jeddah (Saudi Arabia)

Discover Jeddah, a major port city regarded as the gateway to the holy cities of Mecca and Medina for Muslim pilgrims. The city's historical district, Al-Balad, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site dating back to the 7th century. Take a stroll through the narrow streets to admire the traditional homes made from coral stone, sourced from the Red Sea and explore the vibrant souks.

Arrives On: 30 Nov 27

Day 12: Jeddah (Saudi Arabia)

Your luxurious yacht cruise concludes in Saudi Arabia and Jeddah. After bidding farewell to your crew and fellow guests, from the yacht, you'll be transferred to the airport for your return flight home, or to continue your holiday.
