Day 1: Piraeus (Greece)

A small rocky island embedded in the heart of the Cyclades archipelago, Delos is regarded as one of the most important mythological and archaeological sites in Greece. Take a stroll through the winding narrow streets

Day 4: Lefkáda Island (Greece)

One of the most fascinating places on this beautiful island is the Castle of Agia Mavra, dating back to the 14th century and built to protect Lefkada from invaders. As well as soaking up the island's natural beauty and centuries-old history, enjoy sampling the delicious local wines produced here.</p></p>
