Day 6: Portovenere (Italy)

This endearing seaside port town is famous for the pale and premium Italian marble that is mined and quarried from the nearby mountains. The highly prized Carrara marble not only ranks as one of Italy's most celebrated artisan products but has been used for centuries to create some of the world's most important artistic wonders, including Michelangelo's iconic Statue of David. These shimmering mountains of the purest marble contrast beautifully with the lovely coastal scenery of Marina di Carrara.

Day 8: Livorno (Italy)

Along the western coast of Tuscany, the bustling city of Livorno boasts a modern seaport, but is best known for its scenic beauty, picturesque views of the azure Mediterranean Sea and delicious fresh seafood.
