Day 1: Amsterdam (Netherlands)

Fly from a choice of up to 20 UK airports for the start of your cruise. Welcome to the Netherlands. Here, you will be met at the airport by one of our Emerald Cruises representatives and transferred to your contemporary Emerald Star-Ship.

Tour to Zaanse Schans windmills
Travel to the charming village of Zaanse Schans, just north of Amsterdam. It's famous for its picturesque windmills on the edge of the water, traditional green wooden houses and artisan workshops making traditional handicrafts. This is a quintessentially Dutch town where the smell of freshly baked goods and the sight of spinning windmills offer a truly memorable

Day 3: Rotterdam (Netherlands)

The second-largest city in the Netherlands and the busiest port in Europe, Rotterdam is a modern multicultural hub. Its historic centre was largely destroyed by German bombing in World War II, and the subsequent reconstruction efforts utilised a patchwork of architectural styles, forever altering the city's skyline. It is home to the tallest commercial and residential buildings in the country, a visual symbol of Rotterdam's spirit of innovation.

Private visit to the Mauritshuis and orientation walk in The Hague
Visit the royal and administrative capital of the Netherlands, The Hague. Set on the North Sea coast, the city is home to a thriving cultural and culinary scene, historical monuments, and the International Court of Justice. Within your guided tour, you'll visit the beautiful Mauritshuis museum, home to the best of Dutch painting from the age of Rembrandt and Vermeer, including the famous Girl with A Pearl Earring.

Day 4: Rotterdam (Netherlands)

Spend your morning in Rotterdam. Later, return to your Emerald Star-Ship at lunchtime and cruise to the small town of Willemstad, known for its well-preserved historic fortifications.

Uncover the fascinating architectural legacy of Rotterdam. Its reputation as the city of high-rises has historical roots, beginning with the construction of a 45-metre (148 ft) office building, the Witte Huis, in 1897, which was the tallest office building in Europe. Day 7: Amsterdam (Netherlands)

The city comes especially alive in spring, when its streets and parks bloom in a riot of colours.

Visit to Keukenhof Gardens
This morning, you'll visit the iconic Keukenhof Gardens, boasting 32 hectares (79 acres) of spring-flowering bulbs. Open only from March to May each year, more than seven million bulbs are planted, including 800 varieties of tulips. This area is infused with delightful aromas and a swathe of vibrant colours. Soak in the sights of tulips, hyacinths, and orchids of every colour, creating an expertly arranged pattern of beauty. You will also see statues commissioned by world-renowned artists, each adopting the annual theme.

Wake early to visit the largest floral market in the world, the Flower Auction at Royal Flora Holland in Aalsmeer. Be amazed by the brokers working the bustling floor, where more than 45 million flowers change hands every day.
