Itinerary

Day 1: Mainz (Germany)

Welcome to Frankfurt, where you'll be greeted at the airport and transferred to your contemporary Emerald Star-Ship in Mainz. This evening, join your fellow guests for dinner on board as you cruise towards Wiesbaden, where you'll dock overnight.

Emerald Cruises transfers are only available for flights arriving into Frankfurt prior to 04:00 PM.

Day 2: Wiesbaden (Germany)

Wiesbaden is an elegant historic spa town and the capital of Hesse, set near the Rhine at the edge of the Taunus hills. Known for its long thermal spa tradition and 26 hot springs, it combines grand 19th-century architecture, leafy parks and lively cultural life, creating a relaxed yet cosmopolitan atmosphere.

Walking tour of Wiesbaden with spa tradition

Discover the timeless art of relaxation

in Wiesbaden, one of Europe's most celebrated spa towns. Renowned for its natural thermal springs, Wiesbaden has drawn visitors seeking rest and rejuvenation for centuries. Return feeling refreshed, revitalised and connected to one of Europe's great spa traditions.

Day 3: Koblenz (Germany)

Wake in the ancient city of Koblenz, the gateway to the Rhine Gorge. Once a Roman stronghold, it was established around 8 BC for its strategic value. Today, it's a modern park- and flower-filled city with a unique blend of historic and contemporary architecture.

Invigorating walking tour of Koblenz
Your morning excursion in Koblenz blends gentle exercise, riverside beauty and clean eating. It is designed for guests who want to feel refreshed and energised without a strenuous program, just movement, scenery and fresh nutrition. You'll also enjoy a fresh smoothie or cold-pressed juice as a wellness recharge break.

Guided e-bike tour in Koblenz
You may wish to discover Koblenz and the surrounding area on two wheels. Cycle along the banks of the Rhine, cross over bridges, pass the city's most famous sights, and admire pretty villages and vineyards en route.

Eltz Castle visit (extra expense)
Perched on a rocky outcrop in the Eltz Forest, Burg Eltz is considered one of the most magical castles in Germany. With its eight towers and turrets, the beautifully preserved castle looks like something out of a storybook. It has been under the ownership of the same family for over 850 years and contains many original furnishings and interiors to this day, including 15th-century murals.
Activity level: Moderate/Active, Duration: 3.5 hours

Later, cruise through the World Heritage-listed Rhine Gorge, exemplifying the extraordinary beauty of an area that left the philosophers and artists of the German Romanticism movement entranced. Look out for the iconic Lorelei Rock, where a beautiful siren is said to have lured sailors with her song.

Arrives On: 10 Aug 28

Day 4: Mannheim (Germany)

Arrive in Mannheim early this morning. Sitting where the Rhine and Neckar rivers meet, you'll have easy access to one of Germany's largest inland ports and a lively university city. From the river, the skyline blends historic Baroque architecture with industrial heritage, with a grand palace set alongside the compact city centre.

Included Excursion

Morning yoga in the park

Start the day in calm balance with a guided outdoor yoga session in the green heart of Mannheim. Led by a professional instructor, the session focuses on gentle movement, breathwork and mindful stretching, and is suitable for all levels. The natural setting enhances relaxation, allowing guests to reconnect with body and mind while enjoying the quiet atmosphere before the city awakens.

As a mostly flat city, Mannheim is ideal for exploring by bike. Join this guided active tour to make your way past the highlights and along the riverbanks on two wheels.

Travel to the famed spa town of Bad-Dürkheim for an active walk through the beautiful vineyards of Fritz Ritter Winery. Learn the story of this family-owned winery that dates back nine generations and taste their delicious wines. You can also see 400-year-old oak trees and the largest ginkgo tree in Germany.

Day 5: Rastatt (Germany)

Arrive in Rastatt early this morning. A small town on the edge of the Black Forest, it's known for its architectural masterpieces – including one of Germany's most beautiful Baroque palaces – and the glorious landscapes that surround it, complete with thick forest, lush valleys and crystal-clear lakes.

Walking tour of Baden-Baden with spa experience

Today you can relax in the elegant spa town of Baden-Baden, where thermal traditions meet refined contemporary wellness, surrounded by leafy promenades and Belle Époque architecture. You'll unwind in beautifully designed spa facilities, enjoying time to soak in the indoor and outdoor mineral-rich pools, as well as saunas, steam baths and whirlpools. It's a chance to pause and savour the town's soothing atmosphere before returning to the river cruise refreshed.

In one of the most beautiful rooms in the palace, the chamber music hall, also known as the Kammermusiksaal, you'll enjoy a private evening classical concert.

Walking tour of Baden-Baden and entrance to the Casino (extra expense)
Explore Baden-Baden on foot before stepping into a world of elegance and intrigue with a visit to the legendary Casino, one of Europe's most beautiful and historic gaming houses. With its gilded halls, crystal chandeliers, and ornate interiors inspired by French palaces, this 19th-century jewel has hosted royalty, artists and aristocrats for more than 150 years.

Step inside one of Germany's most impressive baroque residences, Rastatt Palace. A short coach transfer from the dock brings you to this magnificent estate, where a guided visit reveals grand state rooms and beautifully landscaped gardens. Afterwards, enjoy free time to explore at your own pace – whether you linger in the gardens or simply soak up the atmosphere.

Activity level: Easy, Duration: 2.5 hours

Day 6: Strasbourg (France)

We arrive in Strasbourg, the medieval capital of France's Alsace Region. Set on the border between France and Germany, the city is a unique blend of cultures, which can be seen in its architecture, language and food. The region also has a strong culture of wellness and pleasure, with mindful indulgence and sensory delights to be celebrated. The World Heritage-listed centre is threaded with beautiful canals lined with traditional buildings and the breathtaking Strasbourg Cathedral, the tallest building in the world for more than 220 years. Tonight on board, enjoy a performance from local bell ringers.

Included Excursion

Alsatian vineyard hike with tasting
Hike through the steeply terraced vineyards of the Alsace, surrounding Strasbourg. See ancient stone terraces that have supported the vines for generations and admire the sweeping views over rolling hillsides, medieval castles and colourful villages. Stop for a tasting of the local varieties, including the famed Alsatian riesling.

Active walk in Strasbourg with a visit to Orangerie Park
Set out on foot to discover the charms of Strasbourg, admiring the historic buildings and pretty canals that wind through the centre. Visit Orangerie Park, the oldest park in the city and a meeting place for locals since the 18th century.

You'll explore the storybook charm of Colmar on a guided walking tour that reveals

its half-timbered houses, canals and historic squares, with time to soak up the atmosphere at your own pace. Wandering through cobbled lanes decorated with window boxes full of colourful blooms, it's easy to imagine the characters from the Grimm's Fairy Tales here.

Day 7: Breisach (Germany)

Perched high above the Rhine River and surrounding vineyards, Breisach is where Germany's Black Forest spills into the lush Alsace region. It's another town with influences from both cultures, as well as a strong passion for wine. It centres around the hilltop St Stephen's Cathedral, an impressive Romanesque-Gothic structure that dominates the skyline and can be seen from a great distance.

Art & nature in Breisach

Reconnect with nature during a relaxing outdoor painting experience in charming Breisach. Surrounded by rolling vines and peaceful landscapes, you'll capture the beauty of the region on canvas while embracing a slower pace of travel. This creative wellness activity offers the perfect opportunity to unwind, find inspiration and immerse yourself in the calming atmosphere of the Rhine Valley.
