Day 3: Koblenz (Germany)

Set beneath leafy trees or along the picturesque banks of the Rhine or Moselle, a local beer garden experience invites you to sip on local brews – like crisp Königsbacher or a smooth Bitburger – served in true German style.

Eltz Castle Visit (extra expense)
Considered one of the most magical castles in Germany, Burg Eltz is perched on a rocky outcrop deep in a valley of the Eltz Forest. Unscathed by wars that have crumbled so many other castles in Germany, Burg Eltz is the epitome of a fairytale castle with eight towers and turrets. It has been under the ownership of the same family for over 850 years and contains many original furnishings and interiors to this day, including 15th-century murals. Inside the castle walls, you can visit the treasury and armoury, which exhibits nine centuries of artefacts.

Day 4: Mannheim (Germany)

Mannheim is a lively university city along the Rhine, best known for its unique grid system, which is why it is often referred to as the 'City of Squares' (Quadratstadt). The city's most famous

landmark is the striking Baroque Mannheim Palace, one of the largest palaces in Europe.

Guided tour of Heidelberg
The enchanting UNESCO World Heritage City of Literature has inspired the likes of Mark Twain and famed British artist, William Turner. Today's fascinating guided tour of the town will unveil its rich history, starting at the Renaissance ruins of Heidelberg Castle, where carefully curated gardens are still peppered with serene water features, sculptures and colourful flowerbeds.

Vineyards hike and wine tasting in Bad-Dürkheim
Visit the quaint wellness town of Bad-Dürkheim for an active hike through the beautiful vineyards. Afterwards, enjoy an orientation walk through town to visit the Fitz-Ritter Winery, which has been in the same family for nine generations. Here, enjoy a special wine tasting.

Day 5: Rastatt (Germany)

Whimsical Baden-Baden is a spa town that has been frequented by celebrities and royalty for centuries. Enjoy a guided walking tour of Baden-Baden, soaking in the nostalgic, elegant boutiques and timeless gardens.

A historic Baroque town in Baden-Württemberg, located on the Murg River near the Black Forest, Rastatt is a former residence of the Margraves of Baden-Baden. It's best known, however, for its 18th-century palace, the Favourite Palace, which hosted the 1714 Treaty of Rastatt, ending the War of the Spanish Succession.

Bruchsal Palace, also known as the Damiansburg, is a breathtaking Baroque Palace noted for its fine Rococo decoration. Made up of over 50 buildings, this impressive complex includes a three-winged residential building with an attached chapel, four pavilions separated by a road, some smaller utility buildings, and an impressive garden. This evening, in one of the palace's most beautiful rooms, you're invited to attend an exclusive private classical concert.

Entrance to the Casino (extra expense)
Step into a world of elegance and intrigue with a visit to the legendary Casino Baden-Baden, considered one of Europe's most beautiful and historic gaming houses. With its gilded halls, crystal chandeliers, and ornate interiors inspired by French palaces, this 19th-century jewel has hosted royalty, artists and aristocrats for over 150 years.
