Day 1: Budapest (Hungary)

Day 2: Budapest (Hungary)

Known as the 'Pearl of the Danube', Budapest presents one of the most cosmopolitan and historic cities in Eastern Europe. The history of this Hungarian capital displays a unique blend of

cultures, cuisine and vibrant lifestyle along with striking contrasts. The 'Buda' district on one side houses a generous scattering of the city's elegant landmarks, while the 'Pest' district on the other side of the river encapsulates its fascinating past. Separated by the mighty Danube, you can explore both districts by crossing the 19th-century Chain Bridge, one of the most symbolic structures in the Hungarian capital.

Budapest tour with Grand Market visit
Today, explore the atmospheric cobblestone streets and medieval quarters of Budapest as you embark on a coach tour through the World Heritage-listed city centre. Your insightful guide will explain all about the Hungarian capital's culinary scene as you tour the neo-Gothic Grand Market, Budapest's largest and most expansive indoor market. Afterwards, you'll have time to explore this vibrant market at your own

Hike to Gellert Hill
If you're feeling more active, you may choose to hike to Gellert Hill with a local guide. The surrounding area has been rebuilt several times, most recently following the air raids of World War II. Several 18th-century Baroque houses remain standing and are best explored along the medieval-era paths and alleyways that encircle Buda

Just beyond Budapest, Etyek presents a tranquil wine region celebrated for its distinctive wines. The area's climate and soil are ideal for cultivating varieties such as Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir. Wineries here mix old traditions with modern methods, and visitors can stroll through cellar-lined streets and enjoy vineyard views. The region's proximity to Budapest makes it a popular destination for wine enthusiasts seeking both quality wines and a peaceful countryside escape. Today, you'll explore the charming wine region of Etyek, strolling through its vineyards and visiting a historic cellar, before enjoying a six-course tasting of local wines.

Just north of Budapest, set along the banks of the Danube, visit the small, picturesque town of Szentendre. On today's fascinating walking tour, stroll the pedestrianised centre of the Old Town and along narrow, cobblestone streets. Soak up the Mediterranean atmosphere that has inspired numerous artists for generations and admire well-preserved Baroque architecture, centuries-old churches and colourful houses. The charming main square, Fo Tér and alleyways leading off here come lined with art galleries, museums and shops.

Day 3: Bratislava (Slovakia)

This morning, relax on board your Emerald Star-Ship as you cruise into Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia. Set along the Danube River at a historic crossroads of Europe, Bratislava blends

ancient Celtic roots with centuries of Hungarian and Habsburg influences. Its compact Old Town is renowned for its Baroque palaces, inviting cafés and the hilltop Bratislava Castle overlooking the river. Rich in history as a one-time coronation city for Hungarian kings, Bratislava today presents a lively centre of Slovak culture and commerce, where Old-World charm meets a vibrant, modern atmosphere.

Today, explore the storied viticultural towns of the Small Carpathian Wine Route, set amid Slovakia's Lower Carpathian Region. Here, delight in sampling some delicious local wines – white, Rosés, sparkling and red wines – at a family-run winery and a historic wine cellar that dates back centuries.

Journey off-the-beaten path to Soviet-era landmarks, such as the Slavín monument, the vast concrete housing estates, post-industrial sites and the Iron Curtain border zone. Day 4: Vienna (Austria)

Austria's grand capital on the Danube, Vienna, perfectly encapsulates the opulence of the Habsburg Monarchy. This magnificent city is celebrated for its ornate imperial palaces, elegant historic centre and rich cultural and artistic heritage – once the residence of prolific composers, including Mozart and Beethoven. Vienna dazzles with illustrious sights such as Schönbrunn Palace, the Hofburg, and Belvedere Palace, all set amidst Baroque architecture and lush gardens.

Renowned museums, including the Kunsthistorisches and Museums Quartier, delight with their world-class collections.

Included Excursion
Panoramic Vienna City Tour and Klosterneuburg, Abbey Wine Tour
Discover Vienna's classical charms as your local guide takes you through the heart of the city, where the Austrian capital's imperial grandeur awaits. The World Heritage-listed historic centre was formerly a fortified Roman frontier city, and a drive around the Ringstrasse, one of the world's most beautiful boulevards, will reveal striking architectural styles, including Renaissance and Baroque, from across the last millennia. Afterwards, enjoy a special wine tour at Klosterneuburg Abbey, overlooking the Danube. Founded in 1114 by Margrave Leopold III of Babenberg, this is one of Austria's oldest and most historically significant monasteries. Visit the historic Press House, beautifully illuminated by a stunning light installation, then descend into the Baroque wine cellar to learn about Austria's renowned 'DAC'

wines. Continue through the barrel cellar, where wines are aged under ideal conditions and conclude with a tasting of four wines (or cloudy apple juices).

If you're feeling more energetic, then explore the outskirts of Vienna on two wheels as part of a guided e-bike tour. Accompanied by a local guide, you'll pedal along picturesque riverbanks and cycling paths to Danube Island. During your e-bike tour, your informative guide will share fascinating stories about Vienna, so you can immerse yourself in a different side of the Austrian capital that many visitors don't get to experience.

Day 5: Weissenkirchen (Austria)

Later, you'll cruise through the World Heritage-listed Wachau Valley and arrive in Melk, a delightful Austrian town. Nestled in the heart of the Wachau Valley and esteemed wine region, Melk's history dates back to Roman times and early medieval rulers such as the Babenbergs. It is perhaps best known for its magnificent Abbey, a Baroque masterpiece resting high above the Danube. This vibrant town charms visitors with its blend of stunning architecture, wonderful river views, and rich cultural heritage, anchored by the world-famous Melk Abbey.

Tour of Melk Abbey
Today, enjoy a guided tour of Melk Abbey, originally a lavish castle gifted to Benedictine monks during the 11th century. Within the ancient library, this opulent Baroque building houses some of the most invaluable and extensive collections of medieval manuscripts and ancient texts in the world, reflecting centuries of monastic scholarship.
