Itinerary

Day 1: Belgrade (Serbia)

Upon your arrival in Belgrade, you will be greeted by one of our Emerald Cruise's representatives and transferred to your contemporary Star-Ship, where a warm welcome awaits you from the captain and crew. This evening, join your fellow guests for dinner on board. Your ship will remain docked here overnight.

Arrives On: 16 Aug 28

Day 2: Belgrade (Serbia)

Serbia's capital awaits today as a guided tour takes you off the beaten track in one of Europe's oldest cities. Where the Sava and Danube Rivers meet, socialist blocks are squeezed between art nouveau masterpieces, and remnants of the Habsburg legacy contrast with Ottoman relics and socialist modernist monoliths.

Highlights of Belgrade

Relax as your coach takes you through the centre of this

peaceful city to see the symmetrical façade of the Church of Saint Sava, one of the world's largest church buildings, the Parliament Building, Republic Square, City Hall and more. Finish with a drive through Belgrade's wealthiest neighbourhoods and past Tito's Mausoleum.

Serbian folklore evening show on board
Watch local musicians and dancers perform traditional dances from around Serbia while wearing authentic, colourful costumes.

Guided e-bike tour in Belgrade
Cycle through Belgrade with a local guide to experience the city's landmarks and natural beauty along the Danube. Learn about the diversity of the local area as well as the history of the city and its people, including the former country of Yugoslavia. Highlights include the Belgrade Waterfront, Staro Sajmiste (former concentration camp), and Ada Island.

Learn the story of Serbian-American Nikola Tesla at the intriguing museum dedicated to the life and work of one of the world's most famous inventors. You'll see magnificent working models of Tesla's machines, his various personal items and his visions of the future.

Day 3: Novi Sad (Serbia)

Serbia's second city is renowned for being the liberal city of music, art and culture. Set on an idyllic stretch of the Danube River, locals enjoy the reputation of living within Serbia's cultural heart. Cradled by a crook in the Danube and shielded by a 17th century fortress, hints of old-world Habsburg charm can be found on the workbenches of Novi Sad's leather shops, carved into its historic facades, and worn on the faces of the dapper locals who frequent its suave cafes and bustling markets. The city's bubbling art and culture scene earned it the title of European Capital of Culture for 2022.

You'll set off for Budapest late this afternoon and dock there overnight.

Guided tour of Novi Sad
Set out on an easy walking tour of the city with a local guide. See the market, Orthodox Cathedral, City Hall, Catholic Cathedral, and enjoy a visit to the Synagogue.

Discover Novi Sad on two wheels with this guided e-bike tour. Ride along the Danube promenade and pass iconic landmarks. Learn about the city's history, culture and local life from your guide while enjoying a leisurely cycling pace.

Day 4: Budapest (Hungary)

Set along the banks of the Danube, Budapest captivates with its striking architecture, vibrant atmosphere and rich history. Hungary's capital brings together the historic hills of Buda and

the lively streets of Pest, connected by the iconic Chain Bridge. Explore a city where grand landmarks, cultural traditions and the energy of modern life come together in a truly unforgettable setting. You'll stay overnight again in Budapest.

Guided coach tour of Budapest
Enjoy a guided tour of the city with your local guide this morning. Explore the World Heritage-listed centre, travelling through the chapters of architecture through the ages from Romanesque to Baroque and classical façades. See the Liberty Statue, Heroes' Square and the Buda Castle district, before a walking tour showcases Matthias Church and the Fisherman's Bastion.

Strap on your walking shoes for a beautiful hike up to the World Heritage-listed site of Gellért Hill. On your walk, take in the stunning views of the Danube River and the city's architecture. You'll pass landmarks like Várkert Bazaar and beautifully landscaped gardens, making this an unforgettable experience in Budapest.

Budapest by night (extra expense)
Experience Budapest after dark as the city's grand boulevards, bridges and riverfront glow into life. You can wander past illuminated landmarks, pause to take in sweeping Danube views, and feel the energy of local cafés and bars, discovering a different side to this storied European capital by night.

Day 5: Štúrovo (Slovakia)

The southernmost town in Slovakia, Štúrovo, sits on the northern bank of the Danube and is connected to the Hungarian city of Esztergom on the other side by the Mária Valéria Bridge. Once the royal seat of Hungary, Esztergom is rich in history and religious heritage.

Tour of Esztergom Basilica and Wine tasting
Visit the monumental Esztergom Basilica, the largest church in Hungary, known for its vast dome and panoramic views over the Danube. Descend into the basilica's historic wine cellars for a tasting of wines traditionally produced and stored beneath this sacred site.

Duration: 1.5 hours

Arrives On: 20 Aug 28

Day 6: Bratislava (Slovakia)

Cobbled streets pave the course for daily life in Bratislava, where winding alleys and gothic architecture blend together to create a truly distinctive Slovakian capital. Enjoy a guided tour of Bratislava Castle, a striking landmark most recently rebuilt in a Renaissance style, that still retains some of its stunning original features.

After your included tour, the afternoon is yours to spend exploring the city on your own or join another tour.

Walking tour of Bratislava
Enjoy a sightseeing tour, including the enchanting Old City. Your local guide will take you through the heart of the city. Pass by the

botanical gardens of the Episcopal Summer Palace, the Old Town Hall and its delightful Renaissance courtyard and the Slovak National Theatre, where busts of famous composers adorn the façade. After your tour, enjoy free time to explore at leisure.

Relax on board in the Horizon Lounge as you listen to local saloon orchestra Afrodite, comprised of five women playing classical arrangements of pop music, evergreens, musical and movie melodies in traditional Slovakian dress.

This active excursion begins at the port of Bratislava, passing the monumental Slovak National Theatre building and continuing to the extensive riverside promenade. Admire the Gothic St. Martin's Cathedral, the most famous sacral building in Bratislava, climb the hill to Bratislava Castle for panoramic views, see St Michael's Gate and walk through the main square.

Skoda tour of post-communist Bratislava (extra expense)

On this truly insightful tour of Bratislava in a Skoda car, you'll learn about life during the Communist era through real personal stories from your guide and enjoy some local authentic refreshments from this time. This off-the-beaten-track tour brings alive the story of Bratislava in the turbulent 20th century.

Day 7: Vienna (Austria)

Discover the Austrian capital's most iconic sights, including its magnificent imperial architecture, historic squares and grand avenues that showcase Vienna's rich cultural heritage and timeless elegance. With a late departure tonight, you'll have more time to soak up the city's charms.

Guided Tour of Vienna

Explore the famous sights of the Ringstrasse and Vienna's World Heritage-listed city centre by coach and on foot. Marvel at the Renaissance-style arches that adorn the façades of the Opera House, the Baroque Burgtheater and the Flemish Gothic Parliament before enjoying time to explore Vienna at leisure.

Learn how generations of local communities relied on the river for trade, transport and cultural exchange, gaining a deeper insight into the heritage of this remarkable region.

Learn more about the history and traditions behind this iconic treat, named after the city where it was created.

Enjoy a unique Bavarian experience as you discover the 800-year-old history of beer and learn about the traditions, folklore and craftsmanship that have shaped the region's brewing culture. Hear stories of how brewing has been passed down through generations

If you feel active, join a hike to Veste Oberhaus, one of the largest surviving castle complexes in Europe. Departing from the ship, you'll cross a bridge over the Danube giving a great view of the confluence of the three rivers. Continue on to the castle and its viewing platform, which has a stunning vista over the city and St Stephen's Cathedral.
