Day 1: Budapest (Hungary)

whimsical cultural elements and historic monuments literally around every corner. Relax as a drive down Andrásy Avenue showcases the decorative façades of neo-Renaissance townhouses and journey to Heroes' Square to see the seven chieftains of the Magyars, as well as the historic Castle District.

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Tastes of Hungary (extra expense)

Embark on a flavourful journey through Budapest's vibrant culinary scene, where tradition meets indulgence. Today's tasting tour invites you to sample iconic Hungarian dishes, such as rich goulash, crispy lángos topped with sour cream and cheese, and sweet chimney cake, fresh from the oven. Sip on the fiery fruit brandy pálinka as you explore bustling markets and hidden eateries, guided by a local expert who brings Hungary's culinary heritage to life with every bite.

Guided tour of Vienna
Explore Austria's capital beginning with a drive along the Ringstrasse, where you'll see some of Vienna's world-famous sights such as the Opera House, Burgtheater, Town Hall, St. Stephen's Cathedral, and the Hofburg Imperial Palace.

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Visit to Schönbrunn Palace (extra expense)
Step into Vienna's imperial story with a visit to Schönbrunn Palace. You can explore opulent state rooms, admire ornate detailing and learn how the Habsburg dynasty once lived and entertained, before strolling through grand gardens that frame sweeping views and offer time to absorb the palace's historic atmosphere.

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Viennese evening concert (extra expense)
With Mozart, Beethoven, Strauss and Schubert among its historical repertoire, Vienna is the world capital of opera and classical music. Enjoy an exclusive evening concert at one of Vienna's most beautiful concert halls, with favourites

such as the 'Blue Danube Waltz' and the 'Radetzky March'. A complimentary glass of sparkling wine on arrival adds to the unforgettable occasion.
