Itinerary

Day 1: Vienna (Austria)

Fly from a choice of up to 8 UK airports for the start of your cruise. Welcome to the 'City of Music', Vienna. It has a magical atmosphere over Christmas, with elaborate decorations and more than 20 festive markets. You'll be met at the airport by an Emerald Cruises representative and transferred to your luxurious Emerald Star-Ship, where your friendly captain and crew will be waiting to greet you. As you stay overnight in Vienna, you'll have plenty of time to discover the Viennese markets during the late afternoon hours, while the magical Christmas atmosphere settles in.

Day 2: Vienna (Austria)

This ornate cityscape was home to famous musicians and composers like Mozart and Beethoven, and the father of psychoanalysis, Sigmund Freud. At this time of year, its squares

become enchanting Christmas markets filled with the aromas of cookies, hot punch and roasted chestnuts. The Old City and shopping streets sparkle with festive lights.

Today, it is a recognised World Heritage site for its historic importance, unique grounds and splendid furnishings. Follow a local expert to hear the fascinating tales of the intriguing former residents.

DiscoverMORE Viennese evening concert (extra expense) With Mozart, Beethoven, Strauss and Schubert among its historical repertoire, Vienna is the world capital of opera and classical music. Enjoy an exclusive evening concert at one of Vienna's most beautiful concert halls, with favourites such as the 'Blue Danube Waltz' and the 'Radetzky March'. A complimentary glass of sparkling wine on arrival adds to the unforgettable occasion.

Activity level: Easy, Duration: 2.5 hours

Arrives On: 21 Nov 27

Day 3: Bratislava (Slovakia)

Gothic architecture and fascinating tales of a Communist past welcome you to Bratislava, a capital that has seen much turbulence over the past century. Set at the crossroads of ancient trade routes, this is a place where Baroque palaces, boutiques and cafés adorn medieval cobblestone streets. The Christmas season adds an extra layer to the city, where a blend of distinctive cultures comes together to showcase their handcrafted ornaments and delicious treats.

Included Excursion Walking tour of Bratislava with Christmas market Enjoy a sightseeing tour including the enchanting Old City. Your local guide will take you through the heart of the city. Pass by the botanical gardens of the Episcopal Summer Palace, the Old Town Hall and its delightful Renaissance courtyard and the Slovak National Theatre, where busts of famous composers adorn the façade. After your tour, enjoy free time to explore the Christmas markets at leisure.

Day 4: Budapest (Hungary)

Offering an abundance of historical whimsy, Budapest is known for its architectural diversity and famed monuments that pepper both sides of the Danube. This World Heritage-listed city is a true delight at Christmas, when it becomes a magical winter wonderland of decorations, lights and festive cheer. The locals soak in the city's many thermal baths to beat the crisp chill of the season. Today, your guided coach tour will introduce you to Andrassy Avenue and the neo-Renaissance façades of the townhouses found there, as well as a generous scattering of Christmas decorations.

Guided coach tour of Budapest with Christmas market
Enjoy a guided tour of the city with your local guide this morning. Explore the World Heritage-listed centre, travelling through the chapters of architecture through the ages from Romanesque to Baroque and classical façades. See the Liberty Statue, Heroes' Square and the Buda Castle district, before a walking tour showcases Matthias Church and the Fisherman's Bastion. Afterwards, explore the Christmas market.

Excursion to Szentendre (extra expense)
Visit the picturesque village of Szentendre, where cobblestone streets evoke a Mediterranean atmosphere that has inspired many artists. Take a walking tour through the pedestrian city centre to admire the Baroque architecture, churches, colourful houses and narrow, cobbled streets. The main square, Fo Tér, and the alleyways around it are lined with art galleries, museums and shops.
Activity level: Moderate, Duration: 4 hours

Arrives On: 23 Nov 27

Day 5: Budapest (Hungary)

After breakfast, it's time to say farewell to your fellow guests. Disembark your Emerald Star-Ship for your transfer to the airport for your return flight to the UK and take memories of colourful Christmas markets and crisp winter mornings with you.
