Day 1: Hamburg (Germany)

Day 3: Cowes, Isle of Wight (England)

Cowes is known as the sailing capital of the Isle of Wight and attracts sailing enthusiasts from all over the world every year. In addition to the sport of sailing, Cowes is full of charming streets, boutiques, cafes and restaurants along the promenade. Highlights include the famous Cowes Week regatta, the maritime museum, Osborne House and beautiful beaches.

Day 5: Saint Mary's, Isles of Scilly (England)

Succulents from Mexico, aloe plants from the Canary Islands, rare trees from Australia, and many botanical treasures from South Africa – this diversity is unique in Great Britain.
