Day 1: Kiel (Germany)

For an alternative excursion, head to the popular Baltic resort of Sopot*, which draws beach fans from all over the country in the summer.

Day 4: Malmö (Sweden)

The city lies at the southern tip of Sweden over the water from Copenhagen and is one of the country's most modern metropolises. Yet, here too, the city's long history can be seen in the many old half-timbered houses, a 14th-century church and the famous Malmo Castle. Get to know both sides of Malmo with a walking tour of the old town*.
