Itinerary

Day 1: Piraeus (Greece)

Arrives On: 02 Jul 27

Day 3: Agios Nikólaos, Kríti (Greece)

Set on picturesque Mirabello Bay, Agios Nikolaos attracts visitors thanks to its picturesque location and small inland lake at the port. The name of this enchanting resort goes back to the Byzantine Church of Saint Nicolas, one of the oldest churches in Greece, which stands as testament to the deep historical roots of the region. The island of Crete itself shows its best side: long sandy beaches, deserted bays, high mountain ranges and remote gorges ensure a varied and impressive backdrop. Agios Nikolaos combines these natural riches with its charming character, inviting you to enjoy the beauty of Crete in peace and tranquillity.

Arrives On: 04 Jul 27

Day 4: Monemvasía (Greece)

Off the coast of Laconia in the south-eastern Peloponnese, the unforgettable sight of a majestic rock rises up out of the sea: Monemvasia. The name of this small town means “single passage”, since the pretty labyrinth of narrow streets on the rock is only accessible from the land via a single road. Monemvasia is made up of two parts: the Medieval lower town clings to the steep rock face, while the citadel is perched on top of the cliff. A steep, winding path leads up to the fortress, which offers breathtaking views over the sea and the surrounding scenery – a place that truly brings the past to life.

Day 5: Pýlos (Greece)

Pylos lies in a picturesque spot on the south-west coast of the Peloponnese, surrounded by olive groves, pine forests and rolling hills, which offer wonderful views over the glittering sea in the circular Navarino Bay. The town is famous for the Palace of Nestor, an impressive, well-preserved Mycenaean residence from the Bronze Age, which was mentioned in Homer’s Iliad. The picturesque harbour of Pylos, with its traditional fishing boats and small sailing yachts, is a great place for a stroll along the promenade or for spending time in one of the cosy tavernas.

Arrives On: 06 Jul 27

Day 6: Argostoli (Greece)

Set in a picturesque bay, Argostolion, the capital of the Ionian island of Kefalonia, oozes charm and history. The town’s historic Vallianou Square, surrounded by cosy tavernas, is a great place to enjoy life, while the Church of Agios Spyridon is impressive with its richly decorated interior. The lively waterfront promenade invites you to take a relaxing stroll past impressive harbours and bustling markets, affording an insight into the local way of life. One of the highlights of the town is the De Bosset stone bridge, which stretches 690 m (755 yards) across the bay, connecting Argostolion to the opposite coastline. Just a few kilometres away is Makris Gialos beach with its crystal-clear waters – perfect for soaking up the sun and letting your mind drift.

Day 7: Lefkáda Island (Greece)

Picture-book scenery awaits visitors to the island of Lefkada. The beaches of Porto Katsiki and Egremni, with white sand and turquoise waters promising some unforgettable holiday experiences, are some of the best in Greece. Lefkada is connected to the mainland by a bridge and the main town, also called Lefkada, is an inviting place to discover with its pretty tavernas, colourful shops and lively atmosphere. Away from Lefkada Town, traditional villages and unspoilt scenery show off the more peaceful side to the island and are perfect for hikes and enjoying nature in the beauty of

the Ionian Sea.

Day 8: Corfu (Greece)

Corfu, the greenest island in Greece, boasts a surprising diversity of nature and culture that captivates visitors. Around three million olive trees cover the landscape with their silvery foliage, while cypresses, pine forests and the salty sea air conjure up a distinctive Mediterranean scent. The coasts offer a varied backdrop of long sandy beaches and small, hidden pebble bays, with something for everyone. In the capital Kerkyra, historic castles and medieval churches provide interesting insights into the island's eventful past. Corfu is an island that combines Mediterranean beauty, culture and nature into a unique experience.

Day 9: Sarandë (Albania)

Saranda is a charming pearl on the Ionian Sea with views of the Greek island of Corfu in the distance. Mild temperatures all year round and the lively promenade make this Albanian coastal resort a popular destination, which tempts visitors with its traditional restaurants and authentic atmosphere. The beaches and crystal-clear sea invite you to spend time relaxing, while culture vultures can discover the ancient roots of the town: just a few miles away is the ruined city of Butrint, a UNESCO World Heritage Site offering deep insights into the region's past and emphasising the cultural diversity of Saranda.

Day 10: Kotor (Montenegro)

Nestled in the breathtaking Bay of Kotor, the city on the south-eastern Adriatic inspires with its historical significance and cultural diversity. Surrounded by mighty city walls that extend up the slopes of the surrounding mountains, Kotor has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1979. The Romanesque St. Tryphon Cathedral, which houses the relics of the patron saint, and the charming Venetian palaces make the city a real highlight for lovers of history and culture. Other impressive sights include the Church of St. Luke and the Renaissance-style clock tower.

Day 12: Split (Croatia)

Split, the second-largest city in Croatia, offers a perfect blend of history and modern city life with its Roman legacy and beautiful location on the Adriatic coast. The Riva promenade invites you to relax in one of its many cafes and restaurants, while the hilly forest park on the Marjan peninsula, with its hiking trails and magnificent vantage points, is a green oasis that offers views of the deep-blue sea.
