Day 1: Panama City (Panama)

Arrives On: 20 Jan 28

Day 2: Panama City (Panama)

A fascinating mix of modern elegance and tropical charm awaits visitors to Panama City. The imposing skyline rises above the blue sea, an impressive contrast to the Casco Viejo, the historic old town: colourfully restored buildings and flower-filled courtyards with charming cafes, galleries and squares invite you to while away some time. A walk along the Cinta Costera promenade offers marvellous views of the sea and the city. Vibrant city life combined with exotic flair – Panama City offers an unforgettable urban experience.

Arrives On: 21 Jan 28

Day 2: Port information not found

The daytime passage through the Panama Canal is a unique experience that takes visitors right through one of the world's most important engineering masterpieces. With its impressive locks, the canal connects the Atlantic and Pacific oceans and offers spectacular views of the lush tropical landscape. The famous locks of Miraflores and Gatun play a crucial role in the crossing and allow you to directly experience how nature and technology interact in a fascinating way. Sailing through the Panama Canal is more than just a passage – it is an insight into the heart of a global transport network that connects the world more closely together.

Day 3: San Blas Islands (Panama)

El Porvenir, the main island of the San Blas archipelago, entices visitors with its fine sandy beaches, palm leaves swaying in the gentle breeze and azure-blue waters – a postcard idyll come true in the Caribbean Sea. Take time to admire the intricate craftsmanship at a craft market or learn more about the culture of the Kuna, an Indigenous Panamanian people. However you wish to spend your stay, El Porvenir offers a wonderful combination of nature, relaxation and Caribbean flair.

Day 4: Cartagena (Colombia)

A city full of history and zest for life lies on the Caribbean coast of Colombia: Cartagena de Indias, often referred to as one of the most beautiful cities in South America. Founded in 1533, the “queen of Colombia’s coast” quickly developed into an important trading centre and is now a modern port with historical charm. Salsa beats, a gentle sea breeze and vibrant colours contribute to the atmosphere. The old town has cobbled streets, colonial buildings and exotic plazas to offer. At Plaza de Bolívar, behind the clock tower called Monumento Torre del Reloj, you can stop to sample local Colombian delicacies.

Arrives On: 23 Jan 28

Day 6: Puerto Limón (Costa Rica)

The Caribbean coast around Limón, which is considered one of the most unspoilt provinces of Costa Rica, is around 200 km (124 mi.) long and is blessed with long white sandy beaches and coconut trees. Further inland, the landscape is shaped by rainforests, mountains and mangroves. Parque Vargas, an urban jungle in the middle of the capital Puerto Limón, has special charm – and with a bit of luck, you might even catch a glimpse of sloths here. The region, including Puerto Limón, is still relatively undeveloped for tourism and shows Costa Rica from its authentic and particularly appealing side.

Day 7: Providencia Island (Colombia)

Off the coast of Colombia, Isla de Providencia exudes pure Caribbean flair. Turquoise-blue water, white sandy beaches and the gentle rustling of palm trees invite you to relax and simply enjoy yourself, far away from the hustle and bustle of everyday life. Snorkel through colourful coral reefs and discover the fascinating magic of the underwater world. The warm locals and island life make every moment special.

Arrives On: 26 Jan 28

Day 9: Grand Cayman (Cayman Islands)

George Town, the capital of the Cayman Islands, awaits you with colourful colonial buildings, exclusive boutiques and a long promenade offering views of the crystal-clear Caribbean Sea. The regional diversity is also reflected in the cuisine: try the fresh conch salad or the popular Cayman-style fish at one of the restaurants located directly on the waterfront. Exploring the vibrant underwater world of the Caribbean is also very much worthwhile: impressive coral reefs are found close to the coast that are perfect for snorkelling and diving.

Arrives On: 28 Jan 28

Day 10: Ocho Rios (Jamaica)

Surrounded by lush jungle, Ocho Rios, a small town in the north of Jamaica, developed into a popular destination for holidaymakers from the 19th century. Although the name Ocho Rios means “eight rivers”, only three actually flow into the turquoise-blue bay. Today, visitors will find everything they need for a wonderful holiday – from beautiful beaches to the famous Dunn’s River Falls with romantic waterfalls and natural pools in the middle of the rainforest. The original fishing village has developed into a lively coastal town that perfectly captures the spirit of Jamaica. Enjoy the atmosphere in complete relaxation thanks to a long lay time.

Day 11: Port Antonio (Jamaica)

“No problem” – in Jamaica, this isn’t just a saying, but a way of life. In Port Antonio, you can enjoy the open, warm nature of the Jamaicans and feel a zest for life that is contagious. The island’s natural gems are also enticing: the Blue Lagoon, located east of Port Antonio, invites you to take a refreshing dip in the middle of a tropical bay. Here, underground freshwater springs mix with warm seawater – a unique natural phenomenon and an ideal place for swimming or boating. The dream bay Frenchman’s Cove is also worth a visit – a wonderful place of tranquillity amidst the jungle and the Caribbean Sea.

Arrives On: 30 Jan 28

Day 13: La Romana (Dominican Republic)

La Romana, on the south coast of the Dominican Republic, is a real insider tip for Caribbean flair, beautiful beaches and colonial charm. The region around La Romana enchants all the senses between palm-fringed bays and emerald-green water: on a boat trip to the unspoilt Isla Catalina, colourful coral reefs and crystal-clear water await you, inviting you to snorkel and dive. End your day in style and relaxation in the town's beach bars and lounges with live music and Caribbean cocktails.

Arrives On: 01 Feb 28

Day 15: Puerto Plata (Dominican Republic)

Puerto Plata in the north of the Dominican Republic enchants visitors with its fascinating combination of history and nature. The small fortress of San Felipe has guarded the coast since the 16th century: a silent witness to bygone eras. Stroll through the colourful old town with its charming Victorian houses or take in the view of the city and coastline from the majestic Isabel de Torres mountain – easily accessible by cable car. The surrounding beaches, such as Playa Dorada with its turquoise waters and fine white sand, promise sunny hours by the sea.

Day 16: Grand Turk Island (Turks and Caicos Islands)

Cockburn Town, the capital of the Turks and Caicos Islands, is picturesquely situated on Grand Turk. The enchanting small town captivates visitors with its colonial charm, and you can feel the flair of bygone times in its narrow cobbled streets lined with colourful houses and historic buildings. You can learn a great deal about the islands' eventful history at the Turks and Caicos National Museum, and for a magnificent panoramic view of the coast, it is worth making a detour to the white Grand Turk Lighthouse, the island's landmark. The fresh breeze whets your appetite for seafood in the relaxed atmosphere of the beach bars and restaurants.

Day 17: Inagua (Bahamas)

Those seeking the tranquillity and unspoilt beauty of the Bahamas will find a real treasure on the island of Great Inagua: Northwest Point Beach is a unique paradise for those seeking peace and quiet and nature lovers. Over a mile of pristine white sand and crystal-clear turquoise water invite you to relax, stroll or simply enjoy the breathtaking natural scenery.
