Day 1: Vancouver, British Columbia (Canada)

Where pioneers once sought gold, Alaska's true treasure today is the pristine beauty of its wilderness. Echoing the spirit of Jack London's novels, one of the world's most spectacular sea passages will quench your thirst for discovery. Guided by the profound sense of freedom that once moved early settlers, your adventure begins with a two-day voyage through British Columbia's Inside Passage. From the inspiration Walk, savor views of numerous islands, densely forested mountains, and small settlements slowly passing by. You might spot the first bald eagles soaring through the skies and even chance upon a sighting of whales.

Day 12: Kodiak, Alaska (United States)

The main town of Kodiak Island was the second-largest settlement of Russian America until 1867. Today, the Russian Orthodox Church and the Kodiak History Museum serve as reminders of this era. Explore the charming, small Alaskan town at your own pace. A transfer will take you to Fort Abercrombie State Park1, where you can stroll through the moss-covered coastal forest and past meadows of Arctic flowers. With some luck, you might even spot whales off the coast.

Day 13: Homer, Alaska (United States)

Homer is your starting point for spectacular tours focused on bear watching in the wild: A seaplane takes you on a scenic flight to Brooks Falls1, where you may have the chance to observe brown bears fishing for salmon. Alternatively, you can fly to Lake Clark National Park1, where a hike with a ranger offers additional opportunities to see brown bears in their natural habitat. From Homer, you can actively explore Alaska's unspoiled nature on a hike to a glacier lake or relax on a leisurely boat tour1.

Day 14: Katmai National Park and Preserve, Alaska (United States)

With luck, while cruising the bays of the expansive Katmai National Park aboard the HANSEATIC inspiration, you may have opportunities for bear watching. The bears often inhabit the coastal vegetation here. Alongside your expert guides, you will be on the lookout from the many open deck areas.
