Day 1: Nassau (Bahamas)

Day 2: Staniel Cay (Bahamas)

Part of Exuma Cays, Staniel Cay is a hidden gem in The Bahamas, south of Nassau. It is home to a small village, a yacht club and is famous for the swimming pigs, who have become an attraction paddling in the translucent water of nearby Pig Beach. On Staniel Cay guests can enjoy sun-kissed beaches and a rustic and authentic Bahamian

Cartagena Walking Tour: Explore La Popa Monastery, Castillo de San Felipe,

vibrant Getsemaní, the walled city, and the Gold Museum, ending with a local ice cream.

Day 8: San Blas Islands (Panama)

Zapatilla's Paradise Cayes: Explore Bocas del Toro's Zapatilla Cayes, spot dolphins at Bahia Honda, snorkel vibrant coral at Coral Cay, and relax on the pristine sands of Zapatilla Cay.

Bahia Honda Adventure: Venture through Bastimentos Island on an eco-adventure through mangroves and jungle. Spot sloths, monkeys and exotic birds, hike a tropical trail to see tiny red frogs, and wade through the mysterious Batcave.
