Itinerary

Day 1: Buenos Aires (Argentina)

<p>Latin passion and European romance spark a dynamic combination that makes Buenos Aires the dynamic city its renown for. The crew will greet you personally with a warm welcome and a sparkling glass of champagne as you step aboard your spectacular luxury home for the next 08 nights. Meet fellow passengers and acquaint yourself with your Discovery Yacht's luxuriously appointed offerings. Toast the beginning of your adventure from the top deck's Sky Bar, as you wave farewell to the coast and tap crystal glasses with a hearty "saúde".</p><p>Please book your flight to arrive into Buenos Aires prior to 02:00 PM.</p>

Day 2: Montevideo (Uruguay)

<p>The capital of Uruguay, Montevideo's streets are lined with public buildings and homes that reveal the nation's architectural history. The Plaza de la Independencia, once home to a Spanish fortress, is the centre of the city, leading to gorgeous Art Deco structures and landmarks including the neoclassical Solís Theatre which opened in 1856.</p><p>Visitors will find themselves amongst a vibrant town full of vim and vigour with musical theatre and cosy tango bars right next door to one another. It's also surrounded by an emerging wine region, so delicious drops are always on hand.</p><p>Scenic Freechoice:
Montevideo Highlights: Discover Montevideo's monuments, parks and gardens. Walk the Old Town to see the Cathedral, City Hall and Artigas' Mausoleum in Independence Square, with Solis Theatre nearby. Drive past the Legislative Palace and Prado's historic park, ending with coastal beach views.

Montevideo Ranch Visit: Experience Montevideo's city charm before journeying to Estancia La Rábida, a 3,650-acre farm with vast fields and 650 milking cows. Enjoy a ranch tour, gaucho insights, a traditional asado (barbecue) with wines and meet the owners.

City Highlights & Spinoglio Winery: Begin your journey with a panoramic drive through Montevideo's most iconic sights, then continue to Spinoglio Winery to tour its vineyards and historic cellar, enjoy a guided wine tasting, and delight in a traditional Uruguayan lunch.</p>

Day 3: Punta del Este (Uruguay)

<p>Since the early 20th century, this sun-drenched peninsula has enjoyed a reputation as a favourite holiday destination for the global elite. Referred to as the 'Monaco of the South', Punta del Este's iconic cityscape and incredible beaches attract visitors from all over the world.</p><p>Playa Brava, one of Punta's main beaches, is home to the renowned sculpture of fingertips that emerge from the soft golden sand, called 'La Mano'. Among other sculptures around the city, the art galleries and museums give Punta del Este an artsy, eclectic atmosphere that makes it a stand-out destination.</p><p>Scenic Freechoice:
Punta del Este & Casa Pueblo: Experience Punta del Este's picturesque landscapes, dubbed the Saint Tropez of Latin America, with a scenic drive through San Rafael, Cantegrill, and its iconic wavy bridges. Discover Casapueblo, artist Carlos Paez Vilaró's 13-story masterpiece, exploring its art-filled corridors and terraces with stunning views of the peninsula.

Bike Tour: Enjoy a leisurely bike ride in Punta del Este, along flat paths past Mansa Beach's sea lions and the 1860 lighthouse with French crystals. Discover Nuestra Señora de la Candelaria Church, 'THE HAND' sculpture and historic sites, with photo stops at pristine beaches.

Punta del Este Nature Walk: Just outside Punta del Este, enjoy a guided nature walk up a gentle 170m hill, a natural and cultural heritage site. Discover native flora, ancient history and sweeping views—ending with local treats, herbal tea and live local music at a charming permaculture house.</p>

Day 6: Porto Belo (Brazil)

<p>Today you'll cruise into the picturesque Porto Belo peninsula in southern Brazil. Be amazed by its breathtaking beaches, particularly the Bombas and Bombinhas, which grace the shores of an emerald-green bay. Porto Belo's golden sands and aquamarine waters teeming with marine life make it a haven for swimmers and nature lovers alike.</p><p>Scenic Freechoice:
Camboriu by Cable Car & Schooner: Experience Camboriú's coastal charm on a tour featuring forest trails, panoramic cable car rides, beach time at Laranjeiras and a scenic schooner cruise.

Bombinhas Beach Getaway: Unwind at Bombinhas Beach, a coastal gem near Porto Belo. Enjoy golden sands and clear turquoise waters whilst swimming, sunbathing and discovering local shops and flavours.

Island Ecological Trail Walk: Set out on a one hour guided walk along a 1,300-metre ecological trail. Explore lush Atlantic Forest, encounter native wildlife, uncover ancient carvings and hear the captivating legend of the Golden Angel. </p>

Day 7: Ilhabela (Brazil)

<p>Ilhabela is Portuguese for 'Beautiful Island' and today you'll discover why. After getting photos from your favourite spot on the yacht, disembark for the wonder of this magical destination where volcanic peaks emerge from heavily forested equatorial jungles. It's home to a multitude of waterfalls, flourishing plant species and breathtaking beaches. Watch for wildlife sheltered in this World Heritage-listed biosphere reserve, including capuchin monkeys as they perform their gymnastics in the verdant canopy.</p><p>Scenic Freechoice:
Curral Beach & Agua Branca Natural Pools by Jeep: Embark on a thrilling 4x4 Jeep adventure through tropical island landscapes, with stops at iconic Curral Beach, the serene Água Branca natural pools and Usina Waterfall.

Cabras Island Snorkel: Set sail to Ilha das Cabras Ecological Sanctuary for a guided snorkelling adventure in crystal-clear waters. Discover vibrant marine life and coral reefs, then relax aboard the boat while enjoying scenic views on your return.

Ilhabela Walking Tour: Discover Ilhabela's rich history on a guided walking tour through its charming historic centre. Visit colonial landmarks, museums and art installations, stroll along Saco da Capela Beach, and enjoy time to explore local shops and cultural gems. </p>

Day 8: Parati (Brazil)

<p>Straight from a picture book, Paraty's cobbled streets and chalk-white buildings will have you grabbing your camera. After breakfast on board, venture into the town's friendly streets to begin your day</p><p>Buildings accented with bright swathes of primary colours,

setting off the steeply rising mountains, veiled in emerald leaf cover. There are no cars in the historic town centre, though you may hear the clip-clopping of a horse drawn carriage as you wander the colonial streets. Keep your eyes open for the iconic birds that make this area their home, including jocular toucans, kaleidoscopic parrots and flitting hummingbirds. </p><p>Scenic Freechoice:
Gold Trail by Jeep: Embark on a 4x4 adventure through Serra da Bocaina National Park. Swim in scenic waterfalls, visit a cachaça distillery and explore the historic Gold Trail.

Historic Paraty Walking Tour: Wander Paraty's charming cobblestone streets on a guided tour through its colonial history and gold trade heritage. Admire elegant architecture, and enjoy free time to explore boutiques, local crafts and cozy cafés in this UNESCO-listed town.

Fjord Mamanguá: Embark on the Netuno Expedition speedboat from the pier to explore Saco do Mamanguá, Brazil's only fjord. Discover pristine beaches, jungle and mangroves, swim with tropical fish, turtles and dolphins, and enjoy stops at Engenho Beach, Costa Beach and Ilhote Grande. </p>

Day 9: Rio de Janeiro (Brazil)

<p>Experience a breathtaking start to final morning onboard the Scenic Eclipse as you sail past the iconic Sugar Loaf Mountain (early morning).
