## Itinerary

### Day 1: Civitavecchia (Italy)

Welcome to the Eternal City, where ancient monuments and elaborate churches sit alongside busy cafes and designer boutiques. Your Discovery Yacht will be waiting at Civitavecchia, a Roman port dating back to the second century.

When you arrive, you'll be warmly welcomed on board by the Captain and crew. Meet your butler and settle into your spacious suite. Head to the Sky Bar on Deck 10 to toast the beginning of your Cruise Voyage as you look over the city's twinkling lights.

Please book your flight to arrive into Rome prior to 02:00 PM.

Arrives On: 13 May 25

### Day 2: Gaeta (Italy)

Gaeta is situated on a peninsula in the Tyrrhenian Sea. Considered one of the prettiest towns in this region, this hidden jewel has a scenic historical centre that tumbles down to the sea,

fantastic golden sandy beaches and clear blue waters. Gaeta is popular with Romans looking for a seaside holiday but remains off the tourist trail and only small ships – like your Discovery Yacht – can stop here.

Gaeta is famous for its food and the narrow streets of the medieval Old Town are packed with restaurants. You'll depart late this evening, giving you time to explore the city after dark.

**Freechoice:**   
Villa Tiberio & Archeological Museum: A half-day tour of Sperlonga, a small sea village, and the National Archeological Museum, which features a grotto of Roman marble sculptures.   
Archeological Area of Minturno: A guided tour of Minturno, on the banks of the River Garigliano south of Gaeta, now an archaeological site.   
Gaeta Walking tour: Join this half day guided excursion through the historical centre of Gaeta, represented by three gates.   
Montecassino Abbey & Villa Matilde Winery: Embark on a captivating excursion to Montecassino, where history, spirituality, and cultural richness converge at the renowned Montecassino Monastery, followed by a tasting at Villa Matilde Winery.

Arrives On: 14 May 25

### Day 3: Capri (Italy)

Capri is famous for its jaw dropping beauty; steep green cliffs rise from an impossibly blue sea, elegant villas draped in bougainvillea hide among the hills, and brightly coloured towns line the water's edge. Only small cruise ships and luxurious superyachts can call at Capri, making for an exclusive experience for our guests.

As this is an overnight stop, you'll have time to explore Capri Town by night. Wander the Piazzetta, sit at an outdoor restaurant to sample a fresh, aromatic caprese salad or the famous flourless chocolate cake; and listen for the sound of live music.

**Freechoice:**   
Walking tour of Capri & Augustus gardens - Explore Capri's enchanting heart, starting at Marina Grande pier, where you take the funicular to the main village of Capri.   
Island of Capri by Land & Sea – Discover the beauty of 'The Island of Love,' starting with a cruise along the east coast before ascending to the main village of Anacapri.   
Capri Natural Arch & Capri Town Walking Tour – Visit Capri Town to see the Piazzetta, Via le Botteghe, Via Croce and the Natural Arch. Explore a residential area and admire the views.

Arrives On: 15 May 25

### Day 4: Sorrento (Italy)

A small resort town with a huge reputation, Sorrento is known as the land of lemons and orange groves. It's the birthplace of limoncello liqueur and the gateway to the spectacular Amalfi Coast. Perched on cliffs that plunge into the deep blue of the Mediterranean, Sorrento is a place of peaceful alleyways, pastel-coloured buildings, grand villas and luxury hotels.

**Freechoice:**   
Guided tour of Pompeii: Step back in time at the archaeological site of Pompeii and experience the city as it existed more than

2,000 years ago.  
Hike on the Path of Gods & Positano: A three-hour vigorous hike along a beautiful trail more than 450m above sea level, offering breathtaking views of the Amalfi Coast and Mount Pertuso.  
Walking tour of Sorrento: Explore Sorrento's treasures, including the Valley of the Mills, San Francesco Cloister, and the historic town.  
Taste of Sorrento: Visit a charming farm for an exclusive Italian gastronomy tour and to learn how mozzarella is made and sample hand-crafted delicacies.

Arrives On: 16 May 25

#### Day 5: Porto Cervo (Italy)

Spend this morning relaxing in your suite, perhaps enjoying breakfast on the verandah, or explore some of the indulgent spaces on board. Try a class in the Yoga & Pilates Studio, an invigorating massage in the Senses Spa or a swim with a view in the Vitality Pool.

You'll arrive in Porto Cervo, at the heart of the spectacular Costa Smeralda, at midday. Built as a millionaire's playground by Prince Aga Khan in the 1960s, Porto Cervo oozes luxury with high-end boutiques, stylish restaurants, glamorous nightclubs, world-class golf courses and tennis clubs, and many sumptuous hotels.

**Freechoice:**  
Villages of Sardinia and Coddu Vecchiu Giant's Tomb: Take a scenic guided journey to the archaeological site of Coddu Ecchiu, home of Nuragic funerary architecture, and Baja Sardinia, a delightful summer village.  
Boat tour to La Maddalena: An enchanting ferry voyage to La Maddalena Island and soak in panoramic views of Sardinia's coastline, the Maddalena archipelago and distant Corsica.  
Sardinian Wine Tasting- Enjoy a visit to the typical Sardinian village of San Pantaleo before reaching the winery Piero Mancini for a visit with the owners followed by a wine tasting experience, accompanied by a delightful selection of Sardinian delicacies.

Arrives On: 17 May 25

#### Day 6: Calvi, Corsica (France)

Calvi, on the French island of Corsica, has a long and illustrious history. It was founded in the 13th century and its fiery medieval citadel still stands. It has been a tourist hotspot since the 1920s, thanks to its moon shaped bay lined with a golden, sandy beach and forested mountains on the horizon. Today, it has the feel of a chic resort on the French Riviera, with waterfront restaurants, luxury hotels and multi-million dollar yachts at anchor.

Enjoy another late departure tonight, giving you the chance to spend a delightful evening in Calvi's candle-lit restaurants and al fresco bars.

**Freechoice:**  
Calvi Walking Tour & Wine Tasting: Take a walking tour of Calvi and enjoy breathtaking vistas of red rooftops and the crystal-clear sea before a wine tasting at Domaine Alzipratu.  
Old Villages of Corsica: Visit the ancient circular village of Sant'Antonio, the hilltop village of Pigna and the timeless beauty of Corbara and Aregno on this coastal tour.  
Scenic South Coast

Drive: Discover the beauty of Corsica's southern beaches on this delightful half-day exploration of the island.

#### Day 7: Monte-Carlo (Monaco)

Monaco makes up for its diminutive size with its elegance, glamour and opulence. Monte Carlo, its most famous district, attracts high rollers and prodigious wealth with luxurious high-rise hotels, designer boutiques and beautiful people at every turn. Sleek and stylish Scenic Eclipse fits in perfectly among the private superyachts anchored at the marina.

From Monaco Old Town to the iconic Monte-Carlo Casino, there is much on offer. Discover the history of the Grimaldi royal family, window shop in the designer boutiques that line Avenue de Monte-Carlo or have a drink at the legendary Le Bar Américain inside Hotel de Paris.

**Freechoice:** Old City of Monaco and Monte Carlo City Tour: Explore Monte-Carlo and Monaco Old Town on foot and by bus on this guided tour. Admire Prince's Palace Square and the legendary Monte-Carlo Casino.

Panoramic Monte Carlo & Eze: Discover the medieval village of Eze, which overlooks the Mediterranean. Traverse narrow streets and pass through the ancient double gateway before venturing to Monaco Rock for a guided walking tour.

Saint Paul de Vence Tour: Embark on an unforgettable journey as you explore the breathtaking beauty and captivating galleries of Saint-Paul-de-Vence, one of the French Riviera's oldest towns.

**Enrich** Classic Concert at Oceanographic Museum: Indulge in an evening of elegance and enchantment with a classical concert featuring the renowned Harpsody Orchestra at the prestigious Conference Hall of the Oceanographic.

#### Day 8: Nice (France)
