#### Day 4: Portovenere (Italy)

allowing you the space to relax and experience the town for all that it is. Previously used as a Roman naval station, there is a lot of history for you to explore along this jagged coastline. Popular poets and writers such as Byron, Shelley and Lawrence are known to have fallen in love with the picturesque harbour. #### Day 6: Bastia (France)

<p><span>France's second busiest cruise port (after Calais) and one of the busiest in the Mediterranean, Bastia is the gateway to the island of Corsica. The name comes from the word 'bastion', which is tied to the Genoese fortress that was built here in the 14th century and now houses the interesting Musee de Bastia. The old town is split into two parts; Terra Vecchia around the harbour and Terra Nova in the high-walled citadel above. The narrow laneways are lined with impressive churches, grand public buildings, charmingly jumbled apartment buildings and leafy squares.</span></p><p><strong>Scenic Freechoice: </strong><span><br />Nebio, Patrimonio & Wine Tasting: Enjoy a scenic drive along Corsica's coast to the charming town of St. Florent, passing vineyards, hilltop villages and stunning sea views. Stroll through the town at your leisure before savouring local wines in the famed Patrimonio region.<br /><br />Cap Corse: Explore Cap Corse's wild beauty, visiting Genoese towers, authentic marinas, Nonza's cliffside views and Patrimonio's renowned vineyards. Enjoy a scenic drive over Teghime Pass, immersing in Corsica's heritage and landscapes.<br /><br />Highlights of Bastia: Enjoy a guided walk through Bastia's historic quarters, from lively squares to baroque churches and the hilltop citadel. After exploring key landmarks, take time to soak in the city's authentic Corsican charm at your own pace.<br /><br />Hike in Bastia: Visit Bastia's Oratoire de Monserato, home to the rare Scala Santa, one of only seven holy staircases worldwide, modelled after Rome's famous steps.</span></p><p><span>Offshore: 08:00 - 18:00</span></p>

#### Day 7: Porto Cervo (Italy)

Built as a millionaire's playground by Prince Aga Khan in the 1960s, Porto Cervo oozes luxury with high-end boutiques, stylish restaurants, glamorous nightclubs, world-class golf courses, sumptuous hotels and golden beaches. Very few passenger ships visit Porto Cervo, so you could have this chic town all to yourself, but look out for celebrities on the waiting superyachts or strolling the streets.</span></p><p><strong>Scenic Freechoice: </strong><span><br />Villages of Sardinia & Coddu Vecchiu Giant's Tomb: Embark a scenic walk through San Pantaleo and the ancient Giants' Tomb at Coddu Vecchiu, ending with a relaxing stop in Baja Sardinia.<br /><br />Sardinian Wine Tasting: Set off from Porto Cervo for a scenic drive to the charming village of San Pantaleo, nestled among Sardinia's granite peaks. Then visit a local estate for a guided tasting of regional wines

before a relaxing return through the countryside.<br /><br />Walking Tour of Porto Cervo: Enjoy a brief trolley-train ride to Stella Maris Church for stunning views over Costa Smeralda, then stroll through Porto Cervo's elegant marina and charming streets before some free time to explore at your own pace.</span></p><p><span>Offshore: 08:00 - 18:00</span></p>

#### Day 8: Civitavecchia (Italy)
