Day 1: Barcelona (Spain)

Day 2: Mahón, Menorca (Spain)

Known for its British-style Georgian houses and medieval streets filled with palaces, churches and fortresses, Mahon is truly Vella i Bella - 'Old and Beautiful'. As the capital of the laid-

back island of Menorca, life here is dictated by the slow and gentle waves that lap on the shorelines. Breathe in history during a walk through the old town and gain insight into the great past of the town, a charismatic centre with a charm all its own.
