Day 1: Monte-Carlo (Monaco)

Day 2: Calvi, Corsica (France)

Calvi, on the French island of Corsica, has a long and illustrious history. It has been a tourist hotspot since the 1920s, thanks to its moon shaped bay lined with a golden, sandy beach and forested mountains on the horizon. Today, it has the feel of a chic resort on the French Riviera, with waterfront restaurants, luxury hotels and multi-million-dollar yachts at anchor. Explore the alleys and citadel ramparts of this historic town. Tonight, dine around the world with Scenic Eclipse's extraordinary dining experiences.

Freechoice:

Calvi Walking tour & Wine Tasting-Take a walking tour of Calvi and enjoy breathtaking vistas of red rooftops and the crystal-clear sea before a wine tasting at Domaine Alzipratu.

Old Villages of Corsica: Visit the ancient circular village of Sant'Antonio, the hilltop village of Pigna and the timeless beauty of Corbara and Aregno on this coastal tour.

South Coast Drive: Discover the beauty of Corsica's southern beaches on this delightful half-day exploration of the island.

Day 3: Cannes (France)

Welcome to the cinematic capital of the world. Upon your arrival in late May, the famous Cannes Film Festival will be winding up, and every street and square is abuzz with movie magic. Browse the latest haute-couture collections at the breezy boutiques, relax along the narrow beach, or sip cocktails at one of the endlessly chic beachside bars. There's plenty of history and culture to be found in this coastal enclave, but it's really a place to relax and soak up the glamorous lifestyle alongside the sparkling Mediterranean.

Freechoice:

Cannes by foot: Take a guided tour to the church of Le Suquet. Visit Fortville, a colourful produce market, and stroll la Promenade de la Croisette.

Visit to a Perfume factory and picnic lunch: Visit Grasse, the Capital of Perfume. Take an exclusive tour of a perfume factory, then enjoy a picnic at a nearby country house.

Delights of Cannes: Explore the Old Town of Cannes. Take a guided tour of Croissant Boulangerie Patisserie Le Saint Antoine and a tapenade workshop.

Wine tasting at Chateau St Martin: Escape to the Chateau St Martin in Taradeau. Discover its rich history and sample wonderful local wines.

Arrives On: 29 May 25

Day 4: Saint-Tropez (France)

Saint-Tropez, once a quiet fishing village, became a glamorous travel destination in the 1950s, thanks to Brigitte Bardot and the film *And God Created Woman*. Today, it still retains all the glitz and glamour, alongside glittering blue seas, stunning beaches and a bohemian art scene. Stroll along the cobblestone streets of the old fishing quarter of La Ponche, and revel in the abstract architecture and sunlit landscapes that inspired great artists and filmmakers. With a late departure, see Saint-Tropez come alive after dark.

Freechoice:

Walking tour of Saint-Tropez: Take a guided tour of the charming village of

Saint Tropez and its iconic landmarks.
Grimaud and Port Grimaud: Explore Port Grimaud and the village of Grimaud, with winding alleyways, pastel houses and a monumental fountain.
Visit to Domaine Rayol Gardens: Take a guided tour of this beautiful natural protected site and enjoy a pause gourmande.
Gassin and Wine tasting tour: Stroll the narrow streets of the picturesque Provence village of Gassin and enjoy a tasting at a local winery.
Hiking tour: With a guide, traverse a four-mile coastal trail offering breathtaking views over 3-4-hours.

Arrives On: 30 May 25

Day 5: Sanary-sur-Mer (France)

The town of Sanary-sur-Mer on the French Riviera began life as a fishing village and the marina is still crammed with hundreds of brightly coloured wooden boats. As it is only a small port, your Discovery Yacht will sail to the outside of the harbour and use tenders to take guests ashore right in the centre of town. You'll quickly be charmed by the palm-lined harbour, the quiet pedestrian streets and pastel-hued buildings, all clustered around a 13th century watchtower, which you can climb for sweeping views of the town.

Freechoice:

Bandol & Honey Tasting: Discover Bandol, a seaside resort with beautiful beaches, coves and wine estates. At a typical Miellerie, learn all about the production of honey.

Exploration of La Ciotat: The summer resort of La Ciotat offers turquoise water beaches and visit Le savonnier des Calanques for a tasting of organic olive oil.

E-Bike in Sanary sur Mer: Take a 10km ride through beautiful Sanary via a stunning coastal road.

Castellet & Wine Tasting: Visit Castellet and explore arts and crafts workshops before reaching Provence to sample local wines and olive oil at the Domaine de Fregate winery.

Arrives On: 31 May 25

Day 6: Collioure (France)

This morning, glide into another of the Mediterranean's stunning deep-water harbours. Collioure is adorned with small beaches, castles by the sea, and pink-domed bell towers. Known as the pearl of the Vermillion Coast, Collioure has azure waters lapping pebbled beaches and pastel houses surrounding sun dappled squares. Walk through the town and lose yourself on the streets lined with cafes and gelato shops. With a mix of French and Spanish influences, Collioure is famed for its wine and salted anchovies, both of which are exported all over France.

Freechoice:

Cooking class Taste the mix of French and Spanish cultures: Embark on a journey to Terres des Templiers for a hands-on Catalan culinary experience. Prepare regional specialties reflecting rich Mediterranean influences.

Walking tour of Collioure: Discover the enchanting village of Collioure on a walking tour from the waterfront to the church and the Majorca King's Castle.

Hike and wine: Enjoy a guided coastal hike offering spectacular panoramic views over the bay of Collioure and visit a family

winery tasting.
A day in Carcassonne: See the Narbonne Gate and stroll along the Lists, then proceed to the Basilica of Saint-Nazaire and the 12th century Count's Castle.

Day 7: Roses (Spain)

Step out onto your verandah this morning for a panoramic view of one of the most beautiful bays in the world. The city of Roses is on Spain's Costa Brava, where the mountains meet the sea. Walk through the city's fascinating past at the Ciutadella historic site. Roses is flanked by long, sandy beaches and secluded coves. The surrounding waters are famous for their marine life and snorkeling spots.

You will enjoy a late departure tonight, meaning you can make the most of Roses' famous sunsets. Be sure to sample the local specialty, a delicious Catalan fish stew.

Dali Theatre Museum tour (Figueres): The Dalí Theatre-Museum was conceived and designed by Salvador Dali to capture his surrealism, nuclear mysticism and passion for science.
E-Bike tour with stop for Olive oil tasting: Ride to Empordàlia Villajuiga, where you'll step into the heart of oil making excellence and a decadent tasting session.
Tastes of Emporda: Visit Cadaqués, a picturesque haven for artists and intellectuals, then head to the Martin Faixó Cellar, one of the most renowned wineries in the area.
Girona City tour: Discover the El Call area, one of Europe's best-preserved Jewish Quarters, and explore the medieval city walls.

Day 8: Barcelona (Spain)

Welcome to the spectacular coastal city of Barcelona. One of the most vibrant, cosmopolitan cities in Europe, Barcelona is famous for its beautiful beaches, incredible food, cutting-edge art scene and buzzing nightlife.
