Itinerary

Day 1: Nice (France)

Welcome to France and the bustling city of Nice, one of the most famous ports of the Côte d'Azur. It offers an intriguing blend of French and Italian cultures. You'll be welcomed on board your Discovery Yacht by the Captain and the crew, meet your butler and settle into your spacious verandah suite. Enjoy a late departure from Nice tonight with the opportunity for a sunset stroll along the grand Promenade des Anglais, arguably the most famous stretch of seafront in France or toast to the start of your journey of wonder at the Sky Deck Bar. Please book your flight to arrive into Nice prior to 02:00 PM.

Day 2: Santa Margherita Ligure (Italy)

You'll call into two neighbouring ports today, tucked into a quiet curve of the Ligurian Coast. Santa Margherita is one of the more relaxed towns along the Italian Riviera. Pretty pastel buildings line the shore, hundreds of fishing boats sit in the marina, and the imposing 16th century castle looks out over it all.

At the end of the peninsula is Portofino, one of Italy's most famous resort towns. There's ample time to explore luxury boutiques, swim in the turquoise bay, and look out for celebrities at the exclusive bars.

Freechoice:

Santa Margherita walking tour: Stroll along the sea front promenade with its brightly coloured houses. Then discover the Basilica di Santa Margherita d'Antiochia.

Hiking to Portofino and join the ship in Portofino: From the village of Nozarego, hike along a Mediterranean clifftop path to Portofino, with a picnic along the way.

Brown Castle visit: Explore Brown Castle in Portofino before continuing to the San Giorgio church, a 12th century marvel rebuilt in 1950.

Portofino walking tour with gelato: Take a guided tour of Portofino, visit the San Giorgio church and stop at the Portofino village for a delicious gelato.

Day 3: Carrara (Italy)

Marina di Carrara sits on the coast, tucked between sandy beaches and forested mountains. Today, you can set up in a beach chair beneath a striped umbrella at one of the many beach clubs that line the shore. Or take a shuttle into Carrara town, where everything from fountains to cathedrals to pavements are made from their signature stone. With a late departure, make the most of the town's western aspect and watch the sunset over the water from your private verandah and preferred drink in hand.

Freechoice:

4x4 Marble Quarries Exploration: Visit the Apuane Mountains and trek to its marble quarries, where you'll learn about the extraction and treatment process for Carrara marble. Enjoy lunch with Lardo di Colonnata crouton.

Lucca by E-bike: Explore Lucca's town centre by e-bike, an ideal cycling trail that includes Giacomo Puccini's statue, Piazza San Michele and San Michele Church, the ancient Roman forum and the bustling Piazza Anfiteatro.

Pietrasanta and Forte dei Marmi: A half-day journey to Pietrasanta, a medieval town known as "the Athens of Italy". Your guide will then take you to Forte dei Marmi, an iconic sea village.

Arrives On: 22 May 25

Day 4: Livorno (Italy)

At the third-largest port in Italy, Scenic Eclipse will be a highlight between the giant freighters and passenger cruise ships when it pulls into Livorno this morning. This colourful port town is one of Italy's most cosmopolitan cities. It's also the gateway to the spectacular Tuscany region.

Wander through the 17th-century Venezia Nuova, threaded with canals and connected by bridges. Soak up the flavours of the bustling Central Market, the second-largest indoor market in Europe, where stalls sell fresh vegetables, seafood, charcuterie, cheese and much more. Then, wander the grand Terrazza Magascani along the waterfront, gelato in hand.

Freechoice:

The best of Florence: Visit Florence for a guided tour of the Cathedral square, Ponte Vecchio and Santa Croce square before lunch at a local restaurant.

Highlights of Pisa: Explore Pisa, home of the Leaning Tower. Enjoy a guided walking tour of the tower square and the nearby Pisa Baptistery and Cathedral.

Truffle hunting at the Tuscan farmhouse: Hunt for the tasty prize in the Tuscan woods. Afterwards, enjoy an organic meal at the Tuscan Farm.

San Gimignano & Wine tasting: Take a tour of the medieval hillside town of San Gimignano, followed by lunch and a sampling of local wines.

Arrives On: 23 May 25

Day 5: Saint-Tropez (France)

Saint-Tropez, once a quiet fishing village, became a glamorous travel destination in the 1950s, thanks to Brigitte Bardot and the film *And God Created Woman*. Today, it still retains all the glitz and glamour, alongside glittering blue seas, stunning beaches and a bohemian art scene. Stroll along the cobblestone streets of the old fishing quarter of La Ponche, and revel in the abstract architecture and sunlit landscapes that inspired great artists and filmmakers. With a late departure, see Saint-Tropez come alive after dark.

Freechoice:

Walking tour of Saint-Tropez: Take a guided tour of the charming village of Saint Tropez and its iconic landmarks.

Grimaud and Port Grimaud: Explore Port Grimaud and the village of Grimaud, with winding alleyways, pastel houses and a monumental fountain.

Visit to Domaine Rayol Gardens: Take a guided tour of this beautiful natural protected site and enjoy a "pause gourmande".

Gassin and Wine tasting tour: Stroll the narrow streets of the picturesque Provence village of Gassin and enjoy a tasting at a local winery.

Hiking tour: With a guide, traverse a four-mile coastal trail offering breathtaking views over 3-4-hours.

Arrives On: 24 May 25

Day 6: Villefranche-sur-Mer (France)

Tucked in a deep bay between Nice and the Cap Ferrat peninsula, Villefranche-sur-Mer is one of the hidden gems of the Côte d'Azur. This is a tender port where your Discovery Yacht will wait just offshore as you are transferred right into the centre of town.

Enjoy

a full day to spend in Villefranche-sur-Mer, where you can explore the town or make the short trip into Nice to discover its many museums, historical sites and galleries. A late-night departure allows you ample time to wander along the waterfront to discover its cosy wine bars and glamorous rooftop cocktail spots.

Freechoice:

Eze & Nice with wine tasting & cheese: Stop at Eze for fantastic views before continuing to Nice for a panoramic city tour. Then visit Old Nice and enjoy a wine and cheese tasting.

Tour of Nice: Enjoy a walking tour of Nice. Then visit Old Nice for a walk on the elegant promenade of Cours Saleya.

Pesto workshop & visit to St. Paul: Visit Grasse for a pesto workshop. Afterwards, head to the walled village of St. Paul de Vence.

Formula One & Top Car Museum tour: Take a guided tour of the Monaco F1 Grand Prix circuit and explore Prince Rainier III's classic car collection.

Day 7: Cannes (France)

There's plenty of history and culture to be found in this coastal enclave, but it's truly a place to unwind and enjoy the glamorous lifestyle by the sparkling Mediterranean.

Freechoice:

Cannes by foot: Take a guided tour to the church of Le Suquet. Visit Fortville, a colourful produce market, and stroll la Promenade de la Croisette.

Visit to a Perfumes factory & picnic lunch: Visit Grasse, the Capital of Perfume. Take an exclusive tour of a perfume factory, then enjoy a picnic at a nearby country house.

Delights of Cannes: Explore the Old Town of Cannes and take a guided tour of Croissant Boulangerie Patisserie Le Saint Antoine and a tapenade workshop.

Wine tasting at Chateau St Martin: Escape to the Chateau St Martin in Taradeau. Discover its exceptional history and sample wonderful local wines.

Day 8: Monte-Carlo (Monaco)

Your voyage ends in the breathtaking Monte Carlo. The most famous district in the world's second-smallest country, Monaco, it attracts high-rollers and prodigious wealth with luxurious high-rise hotels, designer boutiques and beautiful people at every turn.
