Day 10: Castellón de la Plana (Spain)

<p>At the heart of the Costa de Azahar (meaning the 'orange blossom coast'), on Spain's eastern edge, is Castellon De La Plana. Smaller and more peaceful than many of the coastal resorts you'll visit, this is an authentic taste of Spanish life, complete with historic sites, bustling markets, and scenic landscapes. Stroll through the lively Plaça Major and savour the vibrant atmosphere of Mercado Central, then visit the Gothic-style Concatedral de Santa Maria and its octagonal bell tower, El Fadri.</p>

Day 11: Barcelona (Spain)

Barcelona is a vibrant city with a rich history, culture, and art scene. The city is known for its stunning sights, such as the Sagrada Familia, a Roman Catholic Church designed by Antoni Gaudi. Notable creatives, including architect Antonio Gaudi, painter Joan Miro, and Pablo Picasso, spent their formative years in Barcelona.
