Day 1: Nice (France)

Day 2: Portofino (Italy)

Brightly coloured buildings sit against crystal-clear water with lush pine-covered hills in the background. Day 3: Calvi, Corsica (France)

<p>Calvi, on the French island of Corsica, has a long and illustrious history. Founded in the 13th century, its fiery medieval citadel still stands above red tiled roofs. It's been a tourist hotspot since the 1920s, thanks to its moon-shaped bay lined with a golden, sandy beach and forested mountains on the horizon.

Today, Calvi has the feel of a chic resort on the French Riviera, with waterfront restaurants, luxury hotels and multi-million-dollar yachts at anchor. Explore the alleys of this historic old town, walk the ramparts of the citadel, and try to find the house that is said to be the birthplace of Christopher Columbus.</p><p>Scenic Freechoice:
Calvi Walking Tour & Wine Tasting: Take a walking tour of Calvi and enjoy breathtaking vistas of red rooftops and the crystal-clear sea before a wine tasting at Domaine Alzipratu winery.

Old Villages of Corsica: Visit the ancient circular village of Sant'Antonio, the hilltop village of Pigna and the timeless beauty of Corbara and Aregno on this coastal tour.

Scenic South Coast Drive: Discover Corsica's diverse landscapes on a half-day tour, from coastal bays to rugged mountains. Enjoy panoramic views, pass historic towers and traverse lush forests.</p><p>Offshore: 08:00 - 18:00</p>

Day 4: Alghero (Italy)

<p>Cross into Italy and the island of Sardinia, sitting off the west coast of the mainland in the Tyrrhenian Sea. The charming city of Alghero is on the island's northwestern tip and is known for its gold sea walls, built in the 16th century. White sandy beaches, crystal clear water and blissful climate make it one of the Sardinia's most popular resorts. Alghero's culture is a fascinating blend of Spanish and Italian (the official language is Catalan) and you'll see it in the architecture, lifestyle and cuisine. </p><p>Scenic Freechoice:
Panoramic Drive & Wine Tasting: Embark on a scenic drive along the Riviera del Corallo, passing an ancient Nuraghe while your guide shares its history. Enjoy breathtaking views from the Capo Caccia panoramic viewpoint, then visit a local estate for a guided wine tasting before returning to Alghero.

>Tour of Alghero & Surroundings: Discover the charm of Alghero, exploring its historic old town with cobblestone streets, Catalan-Gothic architecture, and a picturesque harbor. Explore the surrounding landscapes, enjoying coastal views and local culture.

>Neptune's Grotto & Alghero by Bus: Visit the spectacular Neptune's Grotto at Capo Caccia, descending 654 steps to explore its caves and crystal-clear lakes on a guided tour. Afterwards, return to Alghero for a guided walk through the charming historic town center.</p><p>Offshore: 08:00 - 14:00</p>

Day 5: Saint-Tropez (France)

Join the beautiful people at open-air bars along the waterfront, listen to the sounds of live music and keep an eye out for visiting celebrities. </p><p>Scenic Freechoice:

>Gassin & Wine Tasting: Stroll through the narrow streets of the picturesque Provence village of Gassin and enjoy a tasting at a local winery.

>St Tropez Coastal Hike: Set out on a scenic four-mile coastal hike along a historic trail, guided past Cap Camarat's lighthouse and luxurious villas. Enjoy refreshments and stunning views, then explore St. Tropez or return to the ship.</p><p>Offshore: 08:00 - 22:00</p>
