#### Day 1: Civitavecchia (Italy)

<span>Welcome to the Eternal City, where ancient monuments and elaborate churches sit alongside busy cafes and designer boutiques. Day 2: Sorrento (Italy)

Sorrento is also the gateway to the spectacular Amalfi Coast, which stretches away along the rocky shoreline of the deep blue Mediterranean. Spend your day wandering Sorrento's peaceful alleyways and discover its historic pastel buildings, grand villas, luxury hotels and picturesque cafes. </span>
<span>In the early morning, Scenic Eclipse will set sail towards Capri. Enjoy spectacular views from the open deck as the island's iconic cliffs and shimmering waters come into view, setting the stage for a magical day. </span>

# Day 3: Capri (Italy)

# Day 4: Taormina (Italy)

<span>This morning, you'll sail through the Strait of Messina, which separates the Italian mainland from Sicily. The passage offers stunning views of rugged coastlines and distant mountains on the way to Giardini Naxos. This popular and picturesque seaside resort stands on the site of Sicily's earliest Greek colony, offering a glimpse into the island's ancient past. </span><span>Known as the Jewel of Sicily, Taormina was once a stop on the famed Grand Tour of the 19th century. Today it's packed with luxury hotels, exceptional restaurants and designer boutiques. It's also the gateway to Mount Etna, the largest active volcano in Europe. </span>

### Day 5: Valletta (Malta)

<span>Imposing protective walls and towering bastions announce the Maltese capital of Valletta as you approach by sea. ## Day 6: Tunis (Tunisia)

#### Day 11: Portimão (Portugal)

<span>On the western Algarve, Portimão is a small port with a bustling historic centre. Spend the day exploring this former fishing town, where architectural masterpieces from the 19th and 20th century seamlessly blend with colourful contemporary structures, fronted by a breathtaking promenade. Visit the shops selling traditional lace, ceramics and leather goods, and experience one of the many fantastic restaurants. Admire the steep limestone cliffs that surround its sandy beach of Praia da Rocha and swim in its turquoise waters.

## Day 12: Lisbon (Portugal)

Ferrol. </span><span>Explore the boutiques and Galician-style houses in Ferrol's Magdalena neighbourhood, a declared Historic-Artistic site, and visit the 18th century San Felipe Castle, where bulwarks and cannons defended the city. </span>

Day 15: Aviles (Spain)

<span>Sailing into Avilés, you'll be greeted by stunning views of the picturesque harbour and its beautiful blend of medieval and modern architecture. </span><span>The city's old town, or Casco Antiguo, features a range of well-preserved medieval buildings and streets. Highlights include the Plaza del Carbayedo, a charming square home to a lively weekly market. </span><span>For a deeper dive into the region's heritage, explore nearby Oviedo, a World Heritage site renowned for its rich history and stunning architecture. </span><span>As you sail out of Avilés, unwind at the Sky Bar and share your travel experiences with fellow guests while enjoying panoramic views. </span>

## Day 16: Bilbao (Spain)

<span>Today you'll explore Bilbao, deemed one of the Basque Country jewels.
