Day 1: Civitavecchia (Italy)

Today, its jaw-dropping beauty still draws royalty, celebrities and fashionable travellers from all over the world.

Wander through the Piazzetta and listen to the melodious chiming of the clock tower, admire the impossibly blue ocean as it crashes onto the cliffs, and taste its famous flourless chocolate cake or a fresh caprese salad.</p>

<p>The World Heritage-listed Aeolian Islands are seven volcanic outcrops set off the north coast of Sicily with a rich history dating back to 5000BC. Lipari is the largest and most populated of the islands, known for its pebbled beaches, hiking trails and historic harbour. From its panoramic position, a castle overlooks the seafront of pastel-coloured townhouses, with windswept highlands and steep cliffs in the distance.</p>

Explore quaint fishing villages, relax on the many idyllic beaches and coves and stroll through the largest

square in Greece, the Spianada.</p>

Hvar, the queen of the Croatian Dalmatian islands, known for its sunshine, the pebbly coves of its coastline and medieval history. The Town Square in Hvar is among the most beautiful and the largest in Croatia, and the medieval streets of Hvar Town are a treat to wander on this dreamy island.</p>

Day 9: Dubrovnik (Croatia)

<p>Known as the 'Pearl of the Adriatic', the historic walled city of Dubrovnik has still been largely unchanged since medieval times, surviving both earthquakes and armed combat. Enjoy an entire day exploring the stone streets, admiring the architectural splendour, baroque churches and splashing fountains.</p>

<p>The sixth-largest island in the Adriatic, Korcula, is known as the "Emerald Isle". Explore local vineyards in the villages of Cara and Smokvica, famous for producing Croatia's beloved dry white wine, Pošip.</p>

Day 11: Kotor (Montenegro)

<p>Today, arrive in Kotor, a fortified city nestled between towering mountains and the shimmering Adriatic. This World Heritage-listed setting is brimming with Venetian palaces, cobblestone lanes and café-hemmed squares. Enveloped by medieval walls, Kotor is a place of ancient stories and modern culture.

As your Discovery Yacht departs, enjoy the breathtaking sail away through the Bay of Kotor, with its rugged mountain backdrop and charming,

red-roofed villages lining the shores.</p>

Day 12: Gaios (Greece)
