Dominating the picturesque backdrop is Mount Etna, Europe's largest active volcano, which was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2013.

This charming town, perched high above the Ionian Sea, is famed for its stunning ancient Greco-Roman theatre, beautifully restored medieval buildings, breathtaking vistas, and exclusive atmosphere.

This evening, sail through the scenic Strait of Messina – the historic passage where Sicily meets mainland Italy. Take in the coastal views and a journey steeped in history and legend.

Day 14: Amalfi (Italy)

This morning you'll arrive in Amalfi, the historic village that lends its name to this stunning region. Today, explore the timeless charm of Valletta, from iconic landmarks to hidden treasures nestled in its historic streets. As your yacht departs this evening, admire the golden glow of the city's ancient fortifications, an unforgettable farewell to a truly enchanting destination.

The island's most famous site is the ancient Temple of Apollo, a vast marble gate dating back to 560 BC. Naxos perfectly blends cultural heritage with natural beauty. Whether you're exploring historic sites, tasting local delicacies, or relaxing by the turquoise waters, Naxos offers a quintessential Greek island experience.

Day 37: Kusadasi (Turkey)

Wander lively bazaars and savour Turkish cuisine in the popular seaside resort town of Kusadasi. The port also serves as the gateway to the World Heritage-listed ancient city of Ephesus, renowned for its breathtaking Greco-Roman ruins dating back as far as the 10th century BC. Marvel at Ephesus' grand Library of Celsus and the majestic remains of the Temple of Artemis, one of the original Seven Wonders of the World, echoes of antiquity's splendour.

It marks the border between Asia and Europe and is best known as the site of the Gallipoli campaign in WWI. Enjoy the beautiful views of rugged coastlines, ancient ruins

and rolling hills bathed in golden evening light.</p>
