Itinerary

Day 1: Reykjavík (Iceland)

Your journey begins in the world's northernmost city, Reykjavík, where you'll be greeted at the airport and escorted to your 6-star ultra-luxury Discovery Yacht. Book an early flight to allow time to visit Reykjavik's museums and see its street art before setting sail. Upon boarding, meet Scenic Eclipse's world-class crew and raise a glass of champagne with fellow guests on the Observation Deck as you sail along the Icelandic coastline. Please book your flight to arrive into Reykjavik prior to 02:00 PM.

Day 2: Dynjandi Waterfalls (Iceland)

Ask your butler to bring you breakfast in bed or savour it in the Yacht Club before spending the day getting to know your Discovery Yacht. Feel the excitement building as the Discovery Team explains how your Zodiac and optional helicopter[^], submersible[^],

Scenic Freechoice and other Discovery Excursions will work in the coming days.

Weather permitting, you will visit the jewel of the Westfjords, the Dynjandi waterfall, led by expert guides with an on shore excursion or simply stay on board and view these beautiful falls from the luxury comfort of the observation deck as your Discovery Yacht manoeuvres close by.

Day 3: Grímsey Island (Iceland)

Today you can walk across the official Arctic Circle on Grimsey Island, about 40km off the north coast of Iceland. There are only around 100 people living in a small village by the harbour, but there's also one million seabirds nesting in the island's cliffs. Bird watchers can use the Swarovski telescopes on the Observation Lounge and Deck to take closer looks.

While on board relax and rejuvenate with a treatment# in the Senses Spa, or enjoy infrared saunas, Gessi chromo-therapy showerheads and signature thermal lounges before you arrive in Akureyri for your overnight stay.

Guided Walk: Discover Grimsey, Iceland's northernmost inhabited island, covering just 5.3 km², easily explored on foot.

Passenger Train: Discover Grimsey Island aboard a petite train looping around the lighthouse, village and Arctic Circle Monument, offering a unique glimpse into island life.

Day 4: Akureyri (Iceland)

Iceland's 'capital of the North' is the second largest settlement outside of Reykjavik but with only around 20,000 residents it still feels like a friendly town. Akureyri is a photogenic spot with colourful homes set on green hills at the base of a volcanic mountain chain. See the striking Akureyri Church, and stroll through one of the world's most northerly botanic gardens.

In the evening, settle in at the spacious Scenic Lounge Bar to enjoy your beverage of choice. With Scenic's signature all-inclusive ultra-luxury philosophy, indulge in top

shelf spirits, over 130 whiskeys, a premium wine list and French Champagne.

Freechoice: Panoramic City and Forest Lagoon: Enjoy a city tour of Akureyri and relax in the geothermal spa at Vaðlaskógur forest.

Whale Watching Akureyri: Witness humpback whales performing acrobatics in Eyjafjörður Bay, along with other marine wildlife.

Easy walk around Akureyri: Explore Akureyri, North Iceland's cultural gem, on a leisurely walking tour. Discover historic landmarks, charming 19th-century homes, and vibrant streets filled with cafés and shops, all set against the stunning fjord backdrop.

Leisurely Akureiri & Godafoss Waterfall: Explore Akureyri, the “capital of the North,” enjoy its charming architecture and Botanical Gardens, and visit the stunning Goðafoss Waterfall.

Arrives On: 28 Jul 25

Day 5: Seydisfjörður (Iceland)

Today, you'll arrive in Seyðisfjörður, on the east coast of Iceland. This marks the start of a spectacular six-day circumnavigation of the 'land of fire and ice', during which you'll explore the most dramatic landscapes.

Seyðisfjörður is at the mouth of a beautiful fjord and is the heart of culture, heritage, art, and hospitality in East Iceland. Surrounded by cascading waterfalls, snow-capped mountains, and wandering reindeer and porpoises frequenting the shores, this unique destination will enchant you.

Freechoice:

Chasing Waterfalls – Hike: Experience a breathtaking hiking adventure through the scenic Vestdalur Valley, showcasing stunning landscapes like waterfalls, meadows, wetlands, and ancient human settlements over a thousand years ago.

Vök Baths: Plunge into Iceland's purest hot spring water that comes from naturally heated springs deep below a frozen lake.

History and Heritage Walk: Visit Fjörður's archaeological site and stroll through the town's historic district. Enjoy refreshments at Skaftfell Bistro and explore the Technical Museum.

Skalanes Nature walk: Explore an archaeological site and Skálanes nature center, spotting diverse wildlife. Enjoy scenic views and local refreshments.

RIB Boat Tour - Discover Seyðisfjörður by RIB boat, with wildlife sightings and local stories.

Discovery: Enjoy immersive Discovery experiences such as kayaking and zodiac cruising, subject to weather conditions and harbour master approval.

Arrives On: 29 Jul 25

Day 6: Tórshavn (Faroe Islands)

Start your day in the PURE: Yoga & Pilates Studio or work out in the fully equipped gym. We'll arrive at Tórshavn around lunch time, so you're free to leisurely enjoy the morning with a delicious breakfast after exercising.

Named after Thor, the Norse god of weather, strength, and growth, Tórshavn is one of the world's smallest capital cities and Europe's

least travelled destinations. Towering cliffs, craggy fjords and powerful waterfalls create a wild landscape better explored on one of the Scenic Freechoice excursions. Wander down cobbled alleyways between colourful buildings with grassy roofs and imagine life in Viking times.

Freechoice: Tórshavn the capital: Explore Tórshavn's Old Town, Tinganes, on a guided walk. Visit the National Museum to learn about the Viking and whaling history of the Faroe Islands.

Hiking in Mountains: Hike along Streymoy sill for stunning views of Vágur, waterfalls, and small lakes before returning to Tórshavn.

Vestmanna Sea Cliffs: Sail through Vestmanna's dramatic cliffs, exploring grottoes and bird colonies with stunning sea views.

Countryside of Eysturoy: Visit a sheephouse and explore Faroese history at Blasastova Museum in Gøta.

Coastal Villages: Visit Kollafjørður's church and the distinctive village of Saksun, with panoramic views of its ancient farm and bay.

Day 7: Lerwick, Shetland Islands (Scotland)

The most northerly point of the British Isles, the Shetland Islands sit almost 200 kilometres off the north coast of mainland Scotland. Lerwick is the island group's only town and has a charming waterfront lined with sandstone buildings dating back to the 18th century. The sound of traditional Shetland music can often be heard as you walk through the twisting lanes of this pretty harbour town.

In the evening, explore more of the up to 10 all-inclusive dining experiences on board, sampling fine French cuisine at Lumière or vibrant Asian fusion at Koko's. Alternatively, relax and dine in the comfort of your suite and have your evening nightcap brought by your butler.

Freechoice:

Sumburgh Head to Jarlshof Hike: Travel to the south of the island for a guided hike along Sumburgh Head. Spot thousands of seabirds, dolphins and whales.

Jarlshof and Southern Shores: Visit the remarkable archaeological site of Jarlshof, dating back at least 5,000 years, with an expert guide.

Scenic Shetland, Ponies & Jewellery: Take a scenic drive to the Tingwall Valley to meet a herd of Shetland ponies, then visit the Shetland Jewellery Workshop.

Lerwick Town Walk & Museum: Step back in time and learn about the people of Lerwick on this gentle walking tour, finishing at the Shetland Museum.

Day 8: North Haven, Fair Isle (Scotland)

The southernmost Shetland Island is home to only sixty people and is owned by the National Trust for Scotland. The island is famous for its traditional crafts, including knitwear that is made by hand or with frames, and its abundant bird life.

During your visit, enjoy local hospitality, visit the museum, and have tea with islanders.

Discovery: Join your expert Discovery

Team in a lecture in our state-of-the-art theatre to learn more about why Fair Isle is such an important breeding ground for seabirds and the migratory species that stop here every year.

Arrives On: 01 Aug 25

Day 9: Flåm (Norway)

Take in the views along Sognefjord, the largest fjord in Norway, from Scenic Eclipse's Observation Lounge. Known as the 'King of the Fjords', at its deepest, Sognefjord plunges more than 1,300 metres below you as glide between steep mountains on either side.

One of Norway's most popular destinations, the picturesque village of Flåm is where you can take one of the world's most spectacular railway journeys. The 20km Flam Railway offers unobstructed views of the valley through the steep mountains towards the town centre. For more incredible views take to the skies in one of the on board helicopters.

Freechoice:

- Fjord Safari:** An adventure on board a Rigid Inflatable Boat (RIB) through the spectacular Aurlandsfjord to Beitelen and back, experiencing nature and wildlife at close range.
- Viking Village & Tvinde Water:** Capture the beauty of the Tvinde Waterfall before learning about the Viking era and trying traditional activities at an authentic Viking Village.
- Scenic Flåm Railway:** Admire the stunning scenery and learn about the remarkable engineering of the unique Flåm Railway, including a stop at Kjosfossen Waterfall.
- Brekkefossen Waterfall Hike (led by Discovery Team):** Experience the beauty of Brekkefossen Waterfall on a guided hike. Enjoy a peaceful stroll through Flåm, then ascend to a scenic ledge for stunning views of the falls and valley—a must-see adventure!

Arrives On: 02 Aug 25

Day 10: Flåm (Norway)

The majestic fjord views continue today as you sail through the narrow part of the Nærøyfjorden to reach the Viking village Gudvangen. Situated at the end of the Nærøyfjorden, where the Nærøydalselvi river flows into the fjord, Gudvangen is home to a village where you can learn about Viking culture.

As you sail through Nærøyfjorden, Scenic Eclipse's GPS Dynamic Positioning will maintain location without dropping anchor. The fjord is also one of the best kayaking and stand-up paddleboarding opportunities of your voyage and a chance to quietly glide in a narrow fjord surrounded by steep mountains and beautiful waterfalls.

Freechoice:

- Fjord Safari:** Experience an exhilarating RIB ride through Aurlandsfjord and Nærøyfjord, with stops to admire the stunning natural beauty.
- The Royal Fjord Passage:** Enjoy a scenic journey through Norway's landscapes, including a ride on the Flåm Railway, a visit to Voss, and a picturesque drive to Gudvangen.
- Brekkefossen Waterfall Hike (led by Discovery Team):** Experience the

beauty of Brekkefossen Waterfall on a guided hike. Enjoy a peaceful stroll through Flåm, then ascend to a scenic ledge for stunning views of the falls and valley—a must-see adventure!
Kayaking in Gudvangen: Paddle through breathtaking fjord scenery with a guide, stopping for a picnic at Bleiklindi.
Meet the Vikings: Explore the Viking village of Njardarheimr, learning about Viking life with an authentic Viking guide.
