#### Day 6: Kagoshima (Japan)

#### Day 7: Nagasaki (Japan)

Unravel that journey of rebirth at one of the many moving museums and memorials, such as Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Museum, Peace Park, and National Peace Memorial Hall. Explore a deeper past at the Nagasaki Museum of History and Culture and the Suwa-jinja shrine.<span>This evening, enjoy views from the Sky Deck or Observation Deck as we sail under the glittering lights of the Megami Bridge.

## Day 8: Jeju Island (South Korea)

<span>Enjoy lunch on board as you journey toward the small island of Miyajima this afternoon. Miyajima (which translates to 'Shrine Island' in Japanese) is famous for its Itsukushima shrine and enormous torii gate, which, at high tide, appears to float above the water.

#### Day 11: Matsuyama (Japan)

<span>Choose to salute the sun as it rises over the water this morning during a yoga class at PURE: Yoga & Pilates Studio. Then spend the day discovering the beauty of mountainous Matsuyama on the island of Shikoku.<span>Set on the edge of the gentle Seto Inland Sea, this city is a historic delight, crowned by the hilltop Bitchu-Matsuyama Castle. One of Japan's 12 original surviving castles, visitors may ascend Mount Katsuyama via chairlift to admire the complex that includes two keeps, multiple turrets and cherry blossom-fringed grounds.

#### Day 12: Kochi (Japan)

<span>Take advantage of Scenic Eclipse's unique open bridge policy to appreciate the sunrise alongside the crew, enjoying unrivalled access to the ship's ultimate viewing area.
<span>A place to unearth traditional Japanese culture, the small city of Kochi is a path less travelled for many, making it ripe for your discovery. Walk the streets downtown to observe daily life, explore Kochi Castle, visit Chikurinji Temple at Godaisan Mountain, or perhaps stroll the promenade at Katsurahama Beach.

## Day 14: Shingu (Japan)
