Itinerary

Day 1: Sydney, New South Wales (Australia)

Evening brings time to unwind – perhaps a nightcap at the Dune House or rooftop lounge, gazing at constellations that map stories that stretch back millennia.

Rise early for the Mutitjulu Meander, a walk around the base of Uluru while soft morning light paints the desert in gold. Capture your final photographs of this majestic landscape, then board your flight north to Cairns, gateway to the Great Barrier Reef.
On arrival, settle in for a three-night stay at Pullman Reef Hotel Casino, blending five-star comfort with tropical charm.

Day 14: Asmat, Papua (Indonesia)

Venture into the labyrinth of rivers and mangrove-lined channels that define Asmat Regency, one of Indonesia's most culturally compelling and least-visited regions. Life here unfolds along tidal waterways, where villages stand on stilts above the mudflats and travel is by canoe rather than road.

The Asmat people are internationally celebrated for their powerful woodcarvings—intricate works that honour ancestors and embody stories passed down through generations. In this remarkable corner of South Papua, artistry, ritual and environment remain inseparable, offering a deeply authentic glimpse into a living cultural landscape shaped by water, forest and tradition.

This evening, step into Koko's Asian Fusion for a vibrant dining experience inspired by the diverse flavours of Asia. From sushi to stir-fries, every dish is crafted with authentic ingredients and served in a stylish, modern setting.

Day 15: Triton Bay (Indonesia)

Triton Bay, a remote and pristine corner of West Papua, offers a remarkable encounter with nature. Snorkel in the crystal-clear waters among vibrant coral reefs, tropical fish, and graceful manta rays. Towering limestone karsts rise dramatically from the shoreline, while lush rainforests, alive with birds of paradise and other endemic wildlife, stretch inland. Quaint coastal villages reveal the rhythms of local life, where traditional practices continue alongside breathtaking landscapes. Triton Bay blends exploration, natural wonder, and authentic cultural experiences, offering a rare glimpse into one of Indonesia's most unspoiled and captivating regions.

There are thousands of beaches in Indonesia, yet the ones you'll see today might be the country's most beautiful. The Kai Islands are part of the Maluku Province and are made entirely of white sand and coral. Despite their jaw-dropping beauty, these islands remain far off the tourist trail, and you'll be unlikely to see another visitor.
