## Itinerary

### Day 1: Buenos Aires (Argentina)

Welcome to Buenos Aires, where you'll stay overnight. Perhaps plan to spend some time in the city, known as the 'Paris of South America.' Resplendent with Belle Époque buildings, sidewalk cafes and green spaces, there is the fiery passion of Latin America – a collective love for football, flame-cooked meats (asado) and the tango. Some of the highlights are La Boca, a colourful, creative mecca with an art walk, and San Telmo, a former aristocratic neighbourhood abandoned during a 19th-century epidemic. Mansions were turned into conventillos (shared housing), boutique hotels, antique shops, and tango clubs, exuding a captivating bohemian vibe.

### Day 2: Buenos Aires (Argentina)

Board an included flight from Buenos Aires to Ushuaia, the gateway to Antarctica and the world's southernmost city, nestled on the rugged shores of Tierra del Fuego. The Captain and crew will warmly greet you as you board your ultra-luxury Scenic Discovery Yacht. Raise a glass of Champagne as you set sail on Scenic Eclipse through the legendary Beagle Channel, tracing the path of Charles Darwin's historic voyage. From your private verandah or the Observation Lounge, take in beautiful views of the snow-capped Andean peaks and pristine Patagonian wilderness – marking the beginning of an unforgettable expedition.  
Due to the extraordinary nature of this region, Discovery Excursions throughout your Expedition Voyage are dependent on the weather and ice conditions. Your experienced Captain and specialist polar Discovery Leader, who have made countless journeys to Antarctica, the Falkland Islands and South Georgia will use their expertise to design your voyage from day to day, making the most of your time in this spectacular destination.

#### Day 4: Falkland Islands (Falkland Islands (Malvinas))

Remote and untouched, the Falkland Islands offer a breathtaking sanctuary for wildlife enthusiasts. Home to the world's largest gentoo penguin population, watch as they waddle along the shores, nesting and interacting in their natural environment.  
Spot black-browed albatrosses soaring above and keep an eye out for Cobb's wren and the Falkland flightless steamer duck, two rare species found only here. Your specialist polar Discovery Team – geologists, historians, ornithologists, marine biologists, and glaciologists – will share deep insights into this remarkable ecosystem.

**Scenic Discovery:** Daily experiences during your Expedition Voyage may include cruising on Zodiacs, landing ashore to view vast penguin rookeries, kayaking, stand-up paddleboarding, soaring above in the helicopter and diving below in the submersible.

#### Day 5: Falkland Islands (Falkland Islands (Malvinas))

Weather permitting, visit the capital of the Falkland Islands, Stanley. This charming settlement offers a unique British outpost feel. Visit local shops, see the Christ Church Cathedral with its whalebone arch, or share a pint at an English pub.  
Back on board, share stories with new friends over dinner at Sushi & Saké Bar at Koko's, then enjoy the entertainment in the state-of-the-art theatre and unwind with a nightcap at the Scenic Lounge Bar.

Pay tribute to legendary explorer Sir Ernest Shackleton at his final resting place and explore the remnants of the island's past, where weathered whaling stations and rusting ships stand as enduring symbols of a bygone era.

A paradise for photographers and nature enthusiasts alike, South Georgia offers breathtaking landscapes and unparalleled wildlife encounters. If conditions allow, explore its dramatic shores, where untouched wilderness and striking scenery create the perfect backdrop for unforgettable moments. Be sure to have your camera ready to capture this awe-inspiring destination.

**Scenic Discovery:**  
Explore by Zodiac, kayak, or stand-up paddleboard, with potential shore landings, beach walks, and hikes to historical sites (weather and ice permitting). To further discover South Georgia, book an optional submersible^ experience.

#### Day 13: Antarctic Peninsula (Antarctica)

Slide open the floor-to-ceiling doors of your verandah suite to reveal icebergs sculpted by nature and glacial mountains rising thousands of metres from the ocean. Witness the extraordinary wildlife – graceful seals, breaching whales and thriving penguin colonies. Antarctica is a birdwatcher's delight, home to a variety of species, so keep your eyes peeled for wandering albatrosses, shearwaters, giant petrels and more.

Due to the extraordinary nature of the

region, Discovery Excursions throughout your Expedition Voyage are dependent on the ice and weather conditions. Your experienced Captain and Discovery Leader, who have made countless journeys to Antarctica, will use their expertise to design your voyage from day to day, making the most of 18-20 hours of daylight.

**Scenic Discovery:** Explore by Zodiac, kayak, or stand-up paddleboard with possible shore landings (weather and ice permitting). To see Antarctica from above or below the horizon book an optional helicopter<sup>^</sup> or submersible<sup>^</sup> experience.

#### Day 14: Antarctic Peninsula (Antarctica)

Set out on unforgettable Zodiac excursions to explore breathtaking glaciated bays, tranquil channels, and pristine landing sites. Your dedicated Discovery Team will guide you as you trek across the awe-inspiring Antarctic wilderness, and encounter the adorable chinstrap, Adélie, and gentoo penguins that inhabit this remarkable region.

**Scenic Discovery:** Enjoy daily Discovery Excursions (weather and ice permitting), such as Zodiac cruises around ice formations, stepping ashore to view vast penguin rookeries and seals. Kayak or stand-up paddleboard past icebergs and hear the ice cracking and whales feeding below. Soar above the horizon in one of two helicopters<sup>^</sup> on board, or dive below the surface in the submersible<sup>^</sup> for optional further discovery.

#### Day 15: Antarctic Peninsula (Antarctica)

Various species of penguins can be found in the Antarctic and the sub-Antarctic region, including Adélie, Chinstrap, Gentoo, and the very rare Emperor. Guided by your expert Discovery Team, you'll witness colonies up close; hear their calls and watch as they clumsily waddle along and interact with each other.

Whales are another majestic creature you may encounter, including minke whales, humpback whales or orcas. Watch them up close in a kayak or a Zodiac with your Discovery Team or observe them from the comfort of your ultra-luxury Scenic Discovery Yacht. Whichever way you see them, it's a breathtaking experience.

**Scenic Discovery:** Ask your expert Discovery Team for photography tips so you can best capture the incredible wildlife and landscape around you. To see Antarctica from above or below the horizon book an optional helicopter<sup>^</sup> or submersible<sup>^</sup> experience.

On this unforgettable day, you'll cruise past Antarctica's stunning icy mountains before stepping ashore by Zodiac to immerse yourself in the polar wilderness. With ample time to explore, this voyage ensures you experience the grandeur of these ancient ice formations up close. Back on board, enjoy a warm specialty tea or coffee in the Observation Lounge and take in the views through the Swarovski telescopes.

If you prefer to stay warm, find a prime viewing spot and enjoy the spectacle as fellow guests take the plunge, then join them for a toast with a glass of whiskey or a steaming cup of hot chocolate. **Scenic Discovery:** Subject to weather and ice conditions, glide past towering icebergs on a Zodiac, step onto untouched white snow, and soar over vast mountain ranges by booking an optional helicopter experience<sup>^</sup>. This is one of the world's few remaining pristine wildernesses, awaiting your exploration.

Watch in amazement as massive slabs of ice break away from the glacier's face and thunder into the lake below – an unforgettable spectacle of sight and sound. Stroll along the guided boardwalks for sweeping panoramic views of the vast 250-square-kilometre ice field, then end your day with a celebratory toast amid this breathtaking landscape dominated by the magnificent Perito Moreno Glacier.

Drive across the border into Chile and experience an unforgettable escape at The Singular Patagonia. Check in to your luxury hotel for a four-night Scenic Special Stay.
