Itinerary

Day 1: Paris (France)

Tour begins: 4:00 PM. A transfer is included from Charles de Gaulle International Airport, and Gare du Nord and Gare du Lyon train stations to the ship. Tonight you'll meet your Tauck Director and your fellow family river cruisers at a welcome reception and dinner.

Arrives On: 17 Jul 26

Day 2: Paris (France)

Today your family embarks on an exciting sightseeing adventure through Paris, a city brimming with history, charm, and fun for all ages. Stroll together along bustling boulevards, explore lively neighborhoods, and marvel at impressive architecture that sparks curiosity in both kids and adults. From fascinating landmarks to hidden treasures, every stop offers moments to learn, laugh, and create lasting memories. It's a day designed to bring your family closer while discovering the magic of Paris – from elegant boulevards to charming cobblestone streets, every corner tells a story of

artistic endeavours, history's great stories, and an unforgettable blend of elegance and charm. If you wish, go bicycling along the Seine this afternoon – then join us for a "magical" evening aboard the riverboat.

Arrives On: 18 Jul 26

Day 3: Paris (France)

Your family is off for an adventure of their choosing this morning, including a guided bicycle ride along the River Seine or a walking tour and spy game in hilltop Montmartre, where cobbled streets, the stunning white Sacré-Cœur Basilica, colorful street artists and corner bistros await your discovery. Everyone enjoys a guided visit to Musée du Louvre this afternoon before returning to the riverboat for dinner and cruising to your next stop, Vernon.

Arrives On: 19 Jul 26

Day 4: Giverny (France)

Traveling in France is a feast for the senses. Today you'll hear a lot about the artist Claude Monet when you visit his pink house and painted gardens in Giverny. Dock in Les Andelys this afternoon for a choice of sightseeing – hike up to Château Gaillard and listen to stories about Richard the Lionheart, King of England, who built the fortified castle; or take a guided walking tour of the village of Les Andelys. Dinner is back onboard your riverboat as we head for Caudebec for a full day at Normandy's historic D-Day beaches.

Arrives On: 20 Jul 26

Day 5: Caudebec-en-Caux (France)

You'll feel history all around you today as you learn about the heroes of Normandy's Allied Invasion of June 6, 1944 during up close exploration of D-Day beaches. Visit D-Day sites including Pointe du Hoc and Omaha Beach, plus a poignant stop at the hallowed American Cemetery. Following lunch, the afternoon is spent exploring one of Europe's most unique museums, the D-Day Academy; here you'll have a hands-on opportunity to learn first-hand about World War II. You'll actually touch World War II artifacts, from weapons to wireless radios; put on a workable wireless headset as you climb aboard a Willys jeep or Dodge Command car for a ride between the apple trees; and sample rations that the troops ate while serving here. Drive to Caudebec late afternoon and return to the riverboat to set sail for Rouen.

Arrives On: 21 Jul 26

Day 6: Rouen (France)

Wake up in Rouen, the "museum city of a hundred spires," this morning and walk off your riverboat right into the heart of history. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Rouen grew up along the Seine and was an important city for the Romans, Vikings and Normans as far back as the 3rd century! It became the capital of Normandy in the 10th century and many buildings remain from its heyday in the Middle Ages. William the Conqueror used to hold court here. Richard the Lionheart left his heart here and Joan of Arc was burned at the stake here. Explore the sites today on a guided tour that takes you to Rouen's Notre Dame Cathedral – painted by Claude Monet more than 30 times – Joan of Arc Square and the church where she died – you'll also embark on a photo scavenger hunt.

Arrives On: 22 Jul 26

Day 7: Paris (France)

Travel today to Louis XIV's ornate palace, the Château de Versailles, where you'll have a choice of a guided visit inside the palace or a guided bicycle ride. If you choose the palace visit, be sure to take a walk in the garden – it is just as impressive as the palace, covering 1,976 acres with some 200,000 trees, 50 fountains and 210,000+ flowers. And if you choose to explore by bicycle, you'll also visit Marie Antoinette's farm, created in the style of a miniature Norman village. Bid a fond au revoir to the River Seine at a farewell reception and dinner onboard ship tonight.

Arrives On: 23 Jul 26

Day 8: Paris (France)

Tour Ends: Paris. Disembark this morning in Paris. Transfers are included from the riverboat to Charles de Gaulle International Airport, and Gare du Nord and Gare du Lyon train stations; allow a minimum of three hours for your flight check-in.
