Itinerary

Day 1: Amsterdam (Netherlands)

Arrive at Amsterdam Airport Schiphol. If you have arranged a Uniworld arrival transfer, you will be greeted by a Uniworld representative and transferred to the ship.

Day 2: Amsterdam (Netherlands)

The Netherlands' largest city, Amsterdam, has been an international port and financial center for 400 years. Your choice of excursions today: either a morning visit to the Fabrique des Lumières or a MAKE TRAVEL MATTER® Experience on a canal boat.

Day 3: Zaandam (Netherlands)

Sitting just north of Amsterdam is the quieter town of Zaandam, beloved for its traditional green cottages, windmills, craft shops, and quirky modern touches.

Day 4: Hoorn (Netherlands)

Discover the town of Hoorn's seafaring past, where the swashbuckling derring-do of Dutch explorers will come to life on a guided walking tour of this historic locale.

Day 5: Nijmegen (Netherlands)

For your choice of excursions today, visit the Dutch Freedom Museum, which is dedicated to Holland's struggle for liberation against the Nazis. Alternatively, opt for a walking tour of Nijmegen.

Day 6: Rotterdam (Netherlands)

The Maas Tower, the Montevideo, the Millennium Tower, and the spectacular Erasmus Bridge make for a dazzling skyline. Explore this modern city on a tour that highlights its eco-friendly innovations, or use it as a jumping point for a visit to Mauritshuis museum in The Hague or the colorful windmills of Kinderdijk.

Day 7: Dordrecht (Netherlands)

Your ship docks today in Dordrecht, the oldest city in Holland. With around 1,000 historic monuments seamlessly integrated into the city center, some now home to boutique shops and charming restaurants, the city's past and present mingle to create a rich and distinctive atmosphere.

Day 8: Gent (Ghent) (Belgium)

Belgium's second largest city, Ghent abounds in medieval architecture, but there's nothing museum-like about the city. It's lively and brims with cutting-edge boutiques and galleries.

Day 9: Antwerp (Belgium)

It may be the diamond capital of the world, but Antwerp is also known for a number of other sought-after cultural gems, including Golden Age art and Belgian beer, waffles and fries. Visit Antwerp's striking Cathedral of Our Lady, with its UNESCO-designated belfry and its historic surroundings, or, if you're feeling adventurous, hop on the metro and experience the city like a local.

Day 10: Antwerp (Belgium)

Disembark the ship in Antwerp. If you have arranged a Uniworld departure transfer, you will be transferred to Brussels International Airport for your flight home.
